

Vol 3-6 Sound Problem

The new software on Vol. 3-6 is, for the most part, just great. I am having a problem with the sound level when playing QuickTime for Windows movies. It apparently cranks the mixer VOC level up to maximum on my SoundBlaster Pro 8 and leaves it there!

I noted that the README.TXT file in the QTW directory indicated a problem in a SBPSND.DRV driver dated 2/5/93. It referred to the problem with the rather imprecise term "audio sticks"-- is that what they meant? I downloaded the latest SBPSND.DRV (4/28/93) from the Creative Labs BBS, tried it, no change-- the problem persists.
