## 1.0 - Introducing NetVault 6.5.2

### NetVault 6.5.2

...from BakBone Software is a scalable solution for departments, data centers and enterprises available on UNIX, Linux and Windows NT/W2K operating systems. NetVault is built on a modular software architecture created for expansion, growth and continued enhancement of a growing variety of applications. NetVault also supports various storage network designs, including Storage Area Networks (SAN) and Network Attached Storage (NAS). Providing enterprise-wide control in distributed and centralized environments, NetVault is able to operate in multi-vendor networks and supports a broad range of

## 2.0 - Enhancements

### NetVault 6.5.2

...offers the following support enhancements:

- ▶ **AIT2 WORM support** - NetVault 6.5.2 now offers support for this device.
- ▶ **Multi-block Sizes on Tape** - this enables the technology required for NetVault's **SnapMirror to Tape APM** (for more details on this APM, see the section *The NDMP SnapMirror to Tape APM* on page 3).
- ▶ **NVDB Import/Replication**
- ▶ **NetAPP Data OnTAP 6.2 Support**
- ▶ **NDMP v 4.0 Support (with NetVault's NDMP APM)**

## 3.0 - NetVault Version 6.5.2-specific APMs

### The VaultShare APM

NetVault 6.5.2 will include optional support for a StorageTEK™ ACSLS™ (Automated Cartridge System Library Software) environment. This APM makes it possible for NetVault to share access to ACSLS Libraries with multiple operating platforms and software packages allowing for storage centralization. This APM works (in conjunction with various StorageTEK software applications) with the following operating systems:

- ▶ AIX 4.2/4.3
- ▶ HP-UX 10.20/11.00
- ▶ MP-RAS v3.02
- ▶ Solaris 7/8 (Sparc)
- ▶ Windows NT 4.0
- ▶ Windows 2000

## The Snapshot Management & NDMP SnapMirror to Tape APM's

NetVault 6.5.2 will provide base support for these APM's which will be released later this year.

### *The Snapshot Management APM*

This optional APM will provide support for the generation and recovery of Snapshots generated to Network Appliance Filers. NetVault's Snapshot Management APM, in conjunction with Network Appliance's Snapshot capacity, allows for administration and control of snapshotting as well as recovery of these snapshots through NetVault's GUI. NetVault also allows a user to look into a snapshot and selectively choose individual components for a restore.

### *The NDMP SnapMirror to Tape APM*

This optional APM will provide support for the mirroring of Snapshots generated on Network Appliance Filers. Working in conjunction with Network Appliance's SnapMirror to Tape software, NetVault's **NDMP SnapMirror to Tape Application Plugin Module (APM)** allows for, via NDMP, a quick point-in-time snapshot to be taken of a volume on a filer which is placed on a piece of media (e.g. a tape in a tape drive). Through the use of NetWork Appliance utilities, it is then possible to "mirror" this snapshot to a second filer.
