<u>1. Overview</u>

This program actually creates a virtual drive for you. Virtual means a new drive letter(ie. E:\). It doesn't require you to have a new harddisk if you need a new drive. Just like using fdisk, this program creates a new virtual drive for any of your directories easily. Below are the benefits of using this program:-

A) Unlike fdisk, you don't have to worry about accidentally destroying data on your harddisk.

B) If your CD-ROM is slow, you can copy the entire thing from the CD into your harddisk,

and then create a virtual drive for that directory. This will give you speed and more

memory. All of us know how slow the *Fastest* CD-ROM drive in the market is. More

over, the driver itself requires about 27K of the precious conventional memory.

C) Create new drive letters whenever you feel like it and remove it when you are done.

D) Amaze your friends by having a total of 26 drive letters. WOW!(You can then tell them

that you have over 20 gigs of HD space. :) *By the way, this software is a freeware but if you like it, you can donate some money to any

charitable groups using the name Koshikan Corp.

3. Requirements

You will need: 1. Windows 95/98

2. Free drive letter

If you cannot run this program in pure dos mode, you must boot into Windows 95 first, and then run the program. Then shutdown to dos to use it in dos.

4. Using the program

Using this program is really, really easy. All you have to do is type 'kcdemu'. Then read

everything that pops out, and then enter the directory path of the directory you want to create

the virtual drive. Press enter(DUH). Then enter the drive letter of the

virtual drive you want.

Example (The parts that you are supposed to type are in this colour): <-----The executable kcdemu

(BLAH BLAH BLAH pops out....)

Please enter the path [q to quit]: c:\mydir <-----The directory path Please enter the desired drive [q to quit]: **f**: <------The drive

letter you want to create.

If there is error, skip to Troubleshooting section. If no, Congratulations! You have done it!

If you want to delete a virtual drive (got fed up of it), you can run the program called 'kcddel'. This program deletes a virtual drive entered by you. It can also view virtual drives created.

To run, enter the following:

<-----The executable kcddel (BLAH BLAH BLAH pops out...)

Please enter drive to delete [v to view virtual drives, q to quit]: f: <-----Drive to delete

OR

Please enter drive to delete to view virtual drives, q to quit]: $\mathbf{v} \leq ---$ To view created drives

If you would like to view the drives only without going thru the hassle, run 'kcdview'. It shows you all the created virtual drives.

To create a drive from command line (to run it in autoexec.bat), run kcdline.bat

Here is an example on running kcdline.bat

kcdline c:\mydir i:

Please note that you must not add any slashes($\langle or \rangle$) behind the dir(c: \langle mydir) and virtual drive (i:). Adding the slash will cause things to mess up.

To make the drive created after each boot, enter this into your autoexec.bat file:

c:\pathtokcdemu\runme

I hope that you will enjoy this little program. If you really did enjoy, please send some donation.

5. Troubleshooting

If you receive an error stating 'Parse error #', it means that you have entered some wrong information. Maybe you put in the wrong path or you forgot the colon(:) behind the drive? Most probably, you will receive an error like: Dos Error #3 or something like that If it is so, below is a table on these error: Error# | Meaning | Troubleshooting File not found Make sure you typed in 2 everythin correct. Path not found Make sure you typed in 3 everythin correct. Make sure you have not locked out 5 Access denied any of the files Not enough memory Free up more memory. Most 8 probably conventional.
