Open Opens an existing Tracking List.

Save Saves the active Tracking List using the same file name.

Save As Saves the active Tracking List to a specified file name.

Backup Backs up the active Tracking List.

<u>Print Preview</u> Displays full pages as they will be printed.

<u>Print</u> Prints the active Tracking List.

<u>Password</u> Change the password to protect access to your Tracking List.

Options Change the options of your Tracking List.

<u>Exit</u> Exits Password Tracker Deluxe.

New command (File menu)

Use this command to create a new Tracking List in Password Tracker Deluxe.

If you have the Use Wizards preference turned on, the Tracking List Wizard will guide you through creating a new Tracking List.

You can open an existing Tracking List with the Open command.

Shortcuts

Toolbar:

Keys: CTRL+N

Open command (File menu)

Use this command to open an existing Tracking List.

You can create a new Tracking List with the New command.

Shortcuts

Toolbar:

Keys: CTRL+O

File Open dialog box

The following options allow you to specify which file to open:

File Name

Type or select the filename you want to open. This box lists files with the extension you select in the List Files of Type box.

List Files of Type

Select the type of file you want to open:

*.PWT Password Tracker Deluxe files.

Drives

Select the drive in which Password Tracker Deluxe stores the file that you want to open.

Directories

Select the directory in which Password Tracker Deluxe stores the file that you want to open.

Network...

Choose this button to connect to a network location, assigning it a new drive letter.

Save command (File menu)

Use this command to save the active Tracking List to its current name and directory. When you save a Tracking List for the first time, Password Tracker Deluxe displays the <u>Save As dialog box</u> so you can name your Tracking List. If you want to change the name and directory of an existing Tracking List before you save it, choose the <u>Save As command</u>.

Shortcuts

Toolbar:

Keys: CTRL+S

Save As command (File menu)

Use this command to save and name the active Tracking List. Password Tracker Deluxe displays the Save As dialog box so you can name your Tracking List.

To save a Tracking List with its existing name and directory, use the **Save command**.

File Save As dialog box

The following options allow you to specify the name and location of the file you're about to save:

File Name

Type a new filename to save a Tracking List with a different name. A filename can contain up to 250 characters. Password Tracker Deluxe adds the extension ".pwt".

Drives

Select the drive in which you want to store the Tracking List.

Directories

Select the directory in which you want to store the Tracking List.

Network...

Choose this button to connect to a network location, assigning it a new drive letter.

1, 2, 3, 4 command (File menu)

Use the numbers and filenames listed at the bottom of the File menu to open the last four Tracking Lists you closed. Choose the number that corresponds with the Tracking List you want to open.

Exit command (File menu)

Use this command to end your Password Tracker Deluxe session. You can also use the Close command on the application Control menu. Password Tracker Deluxe prompts you to save untitled Tracking Lists. Changes to a Tracking List are automatically saved.

A dialog box will confirm exiting Password Tracker Deluxe. It is recommended to minimize Password Tracker Deluxe so your passwords are quickly accessible.

Shortcuts

Mouse: Double-click the application's Control menu button.

Keys: ALT+F4

Toolbar command (View menu)

Use this command to display and hide the Toolbar, which includes buttons for some of the most common commands in Password Tracker Deluxe, such as File Open. A check mark appears next to the menu item when the Toolbar is displayed.

See <u>Toolbar</u> for help on using the toolbar.

Toolbar



The toolbar is displayed across the top of the application window, below the menu bar. The toolbar provides quick mouse access to many tools used in Password Tracker Deluxe.

To hide or display the Toolbar, choose Toolbar from the View menu (ALT, V, T).

Status Bar command (View menu)

Use this command to display and hide the Status Bar, which describes the action to be executed by the selected menu item or depressed toolbar button, and keyboard latch state. A check mark appears next to the menu item when the Status Bar is displayed.

See Status Bar for help on using the status bar.

Status Bar



The status bar is displayed at the bottom of the Password Tracker Deluxe window. To display or hide the status bar, use the Status Bar command in the View menu.

The left area of the status bar describes actions of menu items as you use the arrow keys to navigate through menus. This area similarly shows messages that describe the actions of toolbar buttons as you depress them, before releasing them. If after viewing the description of the toolbar button command you wish not to execute the command, then release the mouse button while the pointer is off the toolbar button.

The right areas of the status bar indicate which of the following keys are latched down:

Indicator	Description
CAP	The Caps Lock key is latched down.
NUM	The Num Lock key is latched down.

About command (Help menu)

Use this command to display the copyright notice and version number of your copy of Password Tracker Deluxe.

Shortcut

Toolbar:



Context Help command

Use the Context Help command to obtain help on some portion of Password Tracker Deluxe. When you choose the Toolbar's Context Help button, the mouse pointer will change to an arrow and question mark. Then click somewhere in the Password Tracker Deluxe window, such as another Toolbar button. The Help topic will be shown for the item you clicked.

Shortcuts

Toolbar:

Keys: SHIFT+F1

Title Bar

The title bar is located along the top of a window. It contains the name of the application and document.

To move the window, drag the title bar. Note: You can also move dialog boxes by dragging their title bars.

A title bar may contain the following elements:

- Application Control-menu button Document Control-menu button
- Maximize button
- Minimize button
- Name of the application
- Name of the document
- Restore button

Scroll bars

Displayed at the right and bottom edges of the document window. bars indicate your vertical and horizontal location in the document. The scroll boxes inside the scroll bars of the document.

Size command (System menu)

Use this command to display a four-headed arrow so you can size the active window with the arrow keys.



After the pointer changes to the four-headed arrow:

- 1. Press one of the DIRECTION keys (left, right, up, or down arrow key) to move the pointer to the border you want to move.
- 2. Press a DIRECTION key to move the border.
- 3. Press ENTER when the window is the size you want.

Note: This command is unavailable if you maximize the window.

Shortcut

Mouse: Drag the size bars at the corners or edges of the window.

Move command (Control menu)

Use this command to display a four-headed arrow so you can move the active window or dialog box with the arrow keys.



Note: This command is unavailable if you maximize the window.

Minimize command (application Control menu)

Use this command to reduce the Password Tracker Deluxe window to an icon.

Shortcut

Mouse: Click the minimize icon on the title bar.

Maximize command (System menu)

Use this command to enlarge the active window to fill the available space.

Shortcut

Mouse: Click the maximize icon on the title bar; or double-click the title bar.

Close command (Control menus)

Use this command to close the active window or dialog box.

Double-clicking a Control-menu box is the same as choosing the Close command.

Shortcut

Keys: ALT+F4 closes the Password Tracker Deluxe window or dialog box.

Restore command (Control menu)

Use this command to return the active window to its size and position before you chose the Maximize or Minimize command.

Switch to command (application Control menu)

Use this command to display a list of all open applications. Use this "Task List" to switch to or close an application on the list.

Shortcut

Keys: CTRL+ESC

Dialog Box Options

When you choose the Switch To command, you will be presented with a dialog box with the following options:

Task List

Select the application you want to switch to or close.

Switch To

Makes the selected application active.

End Task

Closes the selected application.

Cancel

Closes the Task List box.

Cascade

Arranges open applications so they overlap and you can see each title bar. This option does not affect applications reduced to icons.

Tile

Arranges open applications into windows that do not overlap. This option does not affect applications reduced to icons.

Arrange Icons

Arranges the icons of all minimized applications across the bottom of the screen.

Modifying The Tracking List

Use the commands on the <u>Edit menu</u> to add, edit or delete P-Tracks on your Tracking List.

To close this dialog box and save any changes you've made, click OK.

To close this dialog box without saving any changes you've made, click Cancel.

Enter the password.

If checked, the Tracking List password is required to send the keystrokes to a program.

If checked, the passwords will never expire.

Enter the sequence of keystrokes to send to the program.

To close Password Tracker Deluxe, click Exit.

To return back to Password Tracker Deluxe, click Cancel.

To minimize Password Tracker Deluxe, click Minimize.

Enter the name of the person registering the program.

Enter your valid registration number.

To read the on-line Registration Information, click Registration Information.

To read the help for the special send keystroke codes, click Special Codes Help.

To add a new word to the list, click Add.

To generate a complex password, choose Complex.

To delete the selected word, click Delete.

List of words used to generate a simple or complex password.

To generate a password consisting of random letters and numbers, choose Random Letters and Numbers.

To generate a simple password, choose Simple.

To modify the list of words used to generate a simple and complex password, click Word List.

To find the class name of a control, click Get Control Class Name. Then, select the control with the left mouse key.

To register your copy of Password Tracker Deluxe by mail, click Register By Mail.

To remove Password Tracker Deluxe from your computer, click Uninstall.

To continue evaluating Password Tracker Deluxe, click Continue.

To backup the active Tracking List, click Backup.

To not backup the active Tracking List, click Cancel.

Enter the file name of the Tracking List backup file.

To select the options to generate a random letter and number password, click Options.

Enter the minimum number of characters for the password.

Enter the maximum number of characters for the password.

Use the up and down arrows to change the minimum number of characters for the password.

Use the up and down arrows to change the maximum number of characters for the password.

To register your copy of Password Tracker Deluxe on-line using the Internet, click Register On-line.

To select the backup file name by browsing your computer, click Browse.

Enter a new password.

To generate a new password, click Generate.

To change the synchronize properties, choose Synchronize.

Print command (File menu)

Use this command to print a Tracking List. This command presents a <u>Print dialog box</u>, where you may specify the range of pages to be printed, the number of copies, the destination printer, and other printer setup options.

Note: The toolbar button prints directly to the printer using the current defaults.

Shortcuts

Toolbar:

Keys: CTRL+P

Print dialog box

The following options allow you to specify how the Tracking List should be printed:

Printer

This is the active printer and printer connection. Choose the Setup option to change the printer and printer connection.

Setup

Displays a <u>Print Setup dialog box</u>, so you can select a printer and printer connection.

Print Range

Specify the pages you want to print:

All Prints the entire Tracking List.

Pages Prints the range of pages you specify in the From and To boxes.

Copies

Specify the number of copies you want to print for the above page range.

Collate Copies

Prints copies in page number order, instead of separated multiple copies of each page.

Print Quality

Select the quality of the printing. Generally, lower quality printing takes less time to produce.

Print Progress Dialog

The Printing dialog box is shown during the time that Password Tracker Deluxe is sending output to the printer. The page number indicates the progress of the printing.

To abort printing, choose Cancel.

Print Preview command (File menu)

Use this command to display the active Tracking List as it would appear when printed. When you choose this command, the main window will be replaced with a print preview window in which one or two pages will be displayed in their printed format. The <u>Print Preview toolbar</u> offers you options to view either one or two pages at a time; move back and forth through the pages; zoom in and out of pages; and initiate a print job.

Print Preview toolbar

The Print Preview toolbar offers you the following options:

Print

Bring up the print dialog box, to start a print job.

Next Page

Preview the next printed page.

Prev Page

Preview the previous printed page.

One Page / Two Page

Preview one or two printed pages at a time.

Zoom In

Take a closer look at the printed page.

Zoom Out

Take a larger look at the printed page.

Close

Return from Print Preview to the editing window.

Print Setup command (File menu)

Use this command to select a printer and a printer connection. This command presents a <u>Print Setup dialog box</u>, where you specify the printer and its connection.

Print Setup dialog box

The following options allow you to select the destination printer and its connection.

Printer

Select the printer you want to use. Choose the Default Printer; or choose the Specific Printer option and select one of the current installed printers shown in the box. You install printers and configure ports using the Windows Control Panel.

Orientation

Choose Portrait or Landscape.

Paper Size

Select the size of paper that the document is to be printed on.

Paper Source

Some printers offer multiple trays for different paper sources. Specify the tray here.

Options

Displays a dialog box where you can make additional choices about printing, specific to the type of printer you have selected.

Network...

Choose this button to connect to a network location, assigning it a new drive letter.

Page Setup command (File menu)

This command is not available.





The following options allow you to customize the send keystroke sequence.

Enter a custom keystroke sequence

Special Codes Help

Choose this button to read the special codes online help.

Get Control Class Name

Choose this button to use the mouse to select a control to get it's class name. Use the left mouse button to select the control.

Notes command (Edit menu)

Use this command the edit the P-Track notes. The P-Track dialog box $\underline{\text{Notes page}}$ will be used to edit the P-Track notes.

If the Tracking List is password protected, you will be asked for the Tracking List password to edit the P-Track notes.

Shortcuts

Use this command to show or hide the display of the first line of the notes.

If the Tracking List is password protected, you will be asked for the Tracking List password to turn the display of the Notes back on.

Favorite P-Track command (System Tray menu)

Use this command to send the selected P-Track's user id, password and notes to a playback window. If the playback window is not found or not defined, the P-Track's shortcut is run.

Special Codes

Special codes for sending keystrokes to a playback window are:

{userid} Send the user id. The current text in the edit control is automatically

selected unless a {noselectall} code precedes this code.

{password} Send the password. The current text in the edit control is automatically

selected unless a {noselectall} code precedes this code.

{password!} Send the password only to a password styled edit control. The current text

in the edit control is automatically selected unless a {noselectall} code

precedes this code.

{notes} Send the notes.

{tab n}Send the tab key n times.{enter n}Send the enter key n times.{escape n}Send the escape key n times.{space n}Send the space bar key n times.

{Fi} Send the function key i. The keys F1 to F24 can be sent. For example:

{F7}.

{pause s} Pause s seconds before sending the next keystroke. For example: {pause

2.5) will pause 2.5 seconds.

{home n} Send the home key n times. {end n} Send the end key n times. {left n} Send the left arrow key n times. {right n} Send the right arrow key n times. {up n} Send the up arrow key n times. {down n} Send the down arrow key n times. Explorer 4 or Microsoft Windows 98.

{control c x} Go to the xth control with the class name c. Use the Get Control Class

Name command to get the control's class name. For example: {control edit 2} will go to the second control with the class name edit. This code does not

work with Microsoft Internet Explorer 4 or Microsoft Windows 98.

{nofindedit} Skip automatically finding the first edit control at the beginning of the

sequence.

{noselectall} For the next {userid} or {password} code, do not automatically select all the

text.

{clipboard userid} Put the user id on the clipboard to be pasted into another program by

pressing Ctrl+V. Choose the "Continue" button to clear the clipboard and

continue processing the send keystrokes sequence.

{clipboard password} Put the password on the clipboard to be pasted into another program by

pressing Ctrl+V. Choose the "Continue" button to clear the clipboard and

continue processing the send keystrokes sequence.

{clipboard notes} Put the notes on the clipboard to be pasted into another program by pressing

Ctrl+V. Choose the "Continue" button to clear the clipboard and continue

processing the send keystrokes sequence.

{ctrl} The next keystroke sent will also have the control key pressed. For

example: {ctrl}v will paste in the current clipboard contents. It is possible to

combine the {alt} and {shift} codes.

{alt} The next keystroke sent will also have the alt key pressed. For example:

{alt}fo will pop-up the file menu and start the open command.

{shift} The next keystroke sent will also have the shift key pressed. For example:

{shift}a will send a capital A.

{ctrlkey n} Send the control key n times. The control key will be pressed and released

without any other keys pressed.

{altkey n} Send the alt key n times. The alt key will be pressed and released without

any other keys pressed.

{shiftkey n} Send the shift key n times. The shift key will be pressed and released

without any other keys pressed.

{pausekey n} Send the pause/break key n times.

{noedit} Obsolete. Works exactly like {nofindedit}.

To send other characters, do not put brackets around the text to send. For example: {userid}{tab}this text is sent as is{tab}{password}{enter}.

An {edit} code is automatically run as the first sequence unless an {edit}, {nofindedit}, {control}, {tabstop} or {clipboard} code is first. For example: {edit}{password}{enter} is exactly the same thing as {password}{enter}.

If none of the default send keystroke sequences work, an easy way to figure out what sequence of codes to use is to use the keyboard to enter the information. Right after the window opens, write down every key pressed. Then, substitute the correct code for the keys you typed. For example, at every point you pressed the tab key, enter the code {tab}. Do not use the mouse at any time when using the method.

If information is going to the wrong edit controls on the window, add or delete extra {tab} codes before the {userid}, {password}, or {notes} code. For example: use {userid}{tab}{tab}{password}{enter} to skip passed the control right before the password entry edit control.

Examples:

To send the user id and password to a dialog box:

{userid}{tab}{password}{enter}

To send the user id and password to a form on a web page:

{userid}{tab}{password}{tab}{space}

To send the user id to the first dialog box then the password to a second dialog box:

{userid}{enter}{pause 1}{password}{enter}

To send the user id and password to a text based program like a terminal emulator or telnet:

{nofindedit}{noselectall}{userid}{enter}{pause 5}{noselectall}{password}{enter}

To only send the password to a dialog box:

{password}{enter}

To send the notes to any edit control:

{nofindedit}{notes}

To use the clipboard to copy the user id and password to a program:

{clipboard userid}{clipboard password}

Generate Password dialog box

The following options allow you to generate a new password:

Method

Select one of the generation methods.

Random Letters and Numbers: this method generates an 8 to 12 character password consisting of random letters and numbers. Choose the Options button to set the minimum and maximum number of characters in the password.

Simple: this method randomly chooses two words from the list and separates them with a dash.

Complex: this method randomly chooses two words from the list. Between the two words and at the end, a number between 0 and 99 may be added. The case of the letters is randomly changed.

Choose this button to change the options for generating a password with random letters and numbers using the Random Password Options dialog box..

Word List

Choose this button to change the list of words used to generate the simple and complex passwords. Use the <u>Word List dialog box</u> to change the list of words.

The new password is placed on the clipboard. Press Ctrl+V to insert the new password in the other program. The clipboard will be cleared after closing this dialog box.

Word List dialog box

The following options allow you to modify the word list for generating a simple or complex password:

Add

Choose this button to add a new word to the list.

Delete

Choose this button to delete the selected word from the list.

To modify an existing word, click on a selected word to go into edit mode.

Scan for Playback Windows command (System Tray menu)

Use this command to check and see if the foreground window is a playback window. If the foreground window is a playback window, automatically send the user id and/or password. A check mark is displayed next to the command if this feature is enabled.

Choose this button to stop the send keystrokes process.

Error: Invalid playback window title

The current foreground window title bar text does not match the playback window title bar text entered for this P-Track.

Here are some tips to help solve this problem:

When entering the Playback Window Title Bar Text, use the Select Playback Window button to automatically enter the correct text for you. Edit the P-Track's properties and when entering the Playback Window Title Bar Text, choose the "Select Playback Window" button. Then, select the Playback Window Title Bar with the left mouse key.

Sometimes the displayed title bar text does not match the text that Windows stores for the window. In this case, you must use the Select Playback Window button.

If the Playback Window Title Bar Text is not always the same, you can use the asterisk (*) wild card character at either the beginning or the end of the title bar text.

When using the wild card character, be sure to include as many common characters as possible.

Make sure you have selected the correct P-Track to send.

The following program options can be set on the System Tray Menu preferences page:

Maximum number of P-Tracks to list

Enter the maximum number of most recently used P-Tracks to list on the system tray pop-up menu.

If checked, the P-Track icons are shown on the system tray pop-up menu.

The following program options can be set on the General preferences page:

Use Wizards

If checked, use the Wizards to create or modify Tracking Lists and P-Tracks.

Stay On Top

If checked, Password Tracker Deluxe will stay visible on top of all other windows.

Scan for playback windows

If checked, Password Tracker Deluxe automatically checks to see if the foreground window is a playback window. If the foreground window is a playback window, automatically send the user id and/or password.

Pause before auto-send

Enter the amount of time, in seconds, to pause before automatically sending a user id and/or password to a playback window.

Confirm exiting Password Tracker Deluxe

If checked, when closing Password Tracker Deluxe, confirm that you want to exit the program as opposed to just minimizing the window.

Register Password Tracker Deluxe with the Windows Shell

If checked, every time Password Tracker Deluxe starts, it will register itself with the Windows Shell. It is not recommended to turn this option off unless you have changed how the Windows Shell interacts with Tracking Lists. For example, turn this option off if you removed the Password Tracker Deluxe Tracking List item from the Windows Explorer right-clicked New pop-up menu. Turn this option off before you change the Windows Shell interface.

Ask to backup

If checked, Password Tracker Deluxe will automatically ask you to backup the active tracking list. Enter the number of days between backups in the edit control.

Use Windows encryption to store Tracking Lists

If checked, Password Tracker Deluxe will use the Windows encryption algorithms to encrypt and decrypt the Tracking List files. With this option on, Tracking Lists are even more secure. You will need to be using Windows 95 B (OSR 2), Windows 98, Windows NT or have Internet Explorer 3 or above installed on your computer in order for this option to be enabled.

When turning this option on, it is recommened to make a backup copy of all your Tracking List files in case there is a problem using the Windows encryption scheme.

Play Sounds

If checked, Password Tracker Deluxe will play a sound to notify you when it will automatically send a P-Track or ask to backup the Tracking List.

Restore command (System Tray menu)

Use this command to restore the main Password Tracker Deluxe window from the system tray.

Error: Password Tracker Deluxe timed-out waiting for playback window

The playback window did not open after running the P-Track shortcut. Password Tracker Deluxe stops waiting for the playback window to appear after 60 seconds has elapsed.

There are two reasons why this happened:

- 1. The playback window never did actually appear.
- 2. The playback window title bar text is not correct. For additional help on making sure the playback window title bar text is correct, read the help for Invalid playback window title.

Error: The control is not a password style edit control

The control that Password Tracker Deluxe is trying to send the password to is not a password style edit control. A password style edit control is one that displays asterisks (*) in place of the actual characters typed.

There are two different ways to correct this problem:

1. Make sure the cursor is placed on the correct edit control. Add extra {tab} send keystroke codes before the {password!} code to move the cursor to the correct edit control.

or

2. Use the send keystrokes code {password} instead.

Error: Timeout: The control was not found

Password Tracker Deluxe was unable to find the given control on the current window. After 60 seconds, Password Tracker Deluxe stops searching for the control.

Here are a few reasons why this error occurs:

1. The class name of the control Password Tracker Deluxe is trying to find is not correct.

Every Windows control has a class name associated with it. Each type of Windows control belongs to a different class name. For example, the standard edit control has the class name "Edit" while the standard button control has the class name "Button".

The send sequence code {edit} searches for default edit control class names. If one of these default edit controls is not found, this error message will appear.

An {edit} code is automatically run as the first sequence unless an {edit}, {nofindedit}, {control}, {tabstop} or {clipboard} code is first. For example: {edit}{password}{enter} is exactly the same thing as {password}{enter}.

There are two different ways to solve this problem.

- a. The simplest way is to begin the send keystrokes sequence with {nofindedit}. This will skip finding one of the default edit controls.
- b. The other way is to specify the class name to find by using the {control} send sequence code. This special code has the syntax {control c x} where 'c' is the class name of the control and 'x' is the order number. You can find the class name of the control by using the Get Control Class Name button on the Custom Send Keystrokes dialog box, then select the control with the left mouse key.

Note: if the P-Track is for a form on a web page and you entered a shortcut for the P-Track or you have the scan for automatic playback windows option turned on, you must implement option b. This is because web pages don't always download at the same speed every time and the cursor is not always on the correct control.

- 2. The control order number is incorrect. To correct this problem, change the number in the send sequence code to a lower number. One way to figure out what number the control is, is to count the number of times you press the tab key to get to the control after the window first opens up.
- 3. The web page still hasn't been completely downloaded from the web site. Just manually send the P-Track when the page is finally displayed.
- 4. If you are using Microsoft Internet Explorer 4 or Windows 98, the edit controls on web page forms are not individual controls. Therefore, the edit controls cannot be found. Just place the cursor in the correct edit control and choose the "Continue" button.

An alternative to adjusting the send keystroke sequence is to place the cursor in the correct edit control and choose the "Continue" button.

Copy User ID to Clipboard command (Edit menu)

Use this command to copy the user id to the Windows clipboard. Press Ctrl+V to insert the user id in another program. The clipboard will be cleared after closing the dialog box.

Scan for Playback Windows Help

If P-Tracks are being sent when they shouldn't be, try one of these tips:

- a. Turn off the scan for playback windows feature. No P-Tracks will ever be automatically sent.
- b. Individually disable the P-Track automatic send that is causing the problem by using the <u>Properties</u> <u>command</u> and disabling automatic send during scan for playback windows on the Preferences page.

If P-Tracks are not being sent when they should be, try these tips:

- 1. Manually send the P-Track so additional information can be stored.
- 2. Turn on the preference to additionally match the playback window text. To turn on this preference, use the <u>Properties command</u> and enable match window text on the Preferences page. This is an advanced feature and is not available if the Wizards are turned on.
- 3. If tip 2 did not work, try disabling the match parent window title bar while keeping the match window text enabled.
- 4. P-Tracks with the playback window title bar text set to "*" will never be automatically sent. Enter the correct playback window title bar text to solve this problem.

P-Tracks for web pages that contain frames should disable the automatic send during scan for playback windows since the title bar text of the browser does not change while navigating around the site.

A P-Track must be sent manually at least once for Password Tracker Deluxe to record additional information to distinguish itself from other P-Tracks with the same playback window title bar text.

Backup command (File menu)

Use this command to backup the active Tracking List. Since your passwords are very important, it is a good idea to regularly backup your Tracking List. A backup ensures that you have a copy of your passwords in case your Tracking List is erased or damaged.

In order to be able to recover your Tracking List in case of a system crash, the Windows encryption algorithms will not be used for the backup files. The standard encryption algorithms will be used instead.

A good practice for backing up your Tracking List is to alternate between 2 different floppy disks. That way, you have an extra backup in case the floppy disk gets damaged. You can write the date of the backup on the label to know which disk is older.

Please be sure to store all backup diskettes in a secure location.

Note: The backup copy of the Tracking List uses exactly the same Tracking List password. If the Tracking List is not password protected, the backup copy won't be either.

Check for an Update command (Help menu)

Use this command to check for an update to Password Tracker Deluxe on the Internet.

If connecting to the Internet using a proxy server that requires authentication, the Check for an Update command will use the user id and password from a P-Track named "Proxy Server". When entering the proxy server user name and password, you are given the option to save the user name and password in a P-Track named "Proxy Server". If the "Proxy Server" P-Track does not exist, it will be added. You can safely change the properties of the "Proxy Server" P-Track to automatically send the password to your browser's authentication dialog box.

Thanks to Andrew Reeves-Hall for helping test the proxy server authentication.

Random Password Options dialog box

The following options allow you to select how the random letters and numbers password gets generated:

Minimum number of characters

Enter the minimum number of characters for the password.

Maximum number of characters

Enter the maximum number of characters for the password.

Registration Information command (Help menu)

Use this command to view the Registration Information.

Register Online command (Help menu)

Use this command to register your copy of Password Tracker Deluxe online using the Internet. Your default browser will be launched to view information on registering Password Tracker Deluxe online.

Before selecting this command, make sure you are already connected to the Internet.

Equally Space Columns command (View menu)

Use this command to equally space the visible columns. You can also double click the empty space on the column headings.
