NovaBoot for Windows NT

NovaBoot for NT prepares materials for four methods of disaster recovery.

The method of disaster recovery appropriate for your case depends on the nature of the system failure.

1. Make Single Boot Diskette

If you cannot get to the NT boot manager when you power up your system, you can boot from this diskette to bypass the problem.

2. Make Emergency Repair Diskette

In some cases this can be used to make all the necessary repairs to recover your NT system. You must boot from the NT setup diskette to access the emergency repair utility which requires this diskette.

3. Make NT Setup Diskettes

If you cannot boot or repair your NT system, you can boot from these diskettes along with your NT CD-ROM to re-install NT.

4. Make Backup and Diskettes for Restore

A backup is created according to the volumes you select. Special 'Restore' Diskettes are also made so that you can restore the data using one simple command, NTDATA.

This provides added protection in case disk files have been damaged or lost, preventing normal restore operations from functioning. Note that you must be able to start NT from

hard disk in order to run this data recovery procedure.
