Help items:

Add (click Add or Edit/Add):

Making this selection will bring up the blank entry browser. Browse to the desired directory, double click on file to add to list.

Remove (click Remove or Edit/Delete):

The current entry(s) will be deleted.

Slice (Click Slice Them or File/Slice Them): This option will slice the files, they will be numbered as such:

FILENAME.SSS FILENAME.s10 FILENAME.s11 FILENAME.s12 etc.

sFILENAME.exe will re-assemble the files.

If the filename is a short path a DOS BAT file will also be created that can re-assemble the files. This file will not be created if the filename being sliced is a long file name.

Options:

Sliced File Path Location:

This option will tell the Slicer where to do what it does.

Current directory: The Sliced files will be stored in the current directory all the time.

Floppy Disk: The Sliced files will be stored on a floppy disk. The program will prompt you for the disks as needed.

Sliced Path: The Sliced files will be stored in this directory all the time.

Slice Size: Change slice size in the edit window. You may select one of the pre-set slice sizes or enter a size of your own. The size of the sliced files is in MB. If you need the slices to be an exact size, you may enter that size in bytes preceded by the @ sign.

EX: @1350000 rather than 1.35 MB (actually 1.28 MB since one K is 1024 bytes).

Del FILE after slice: This option will delete the original file.

Del FILE after contat: This option will delete the sliced files after rebuilding the original file. Right Click Menu Support: This option will enable/disable right click mouse support for slicing files.

Slice is an option when right clicking on any file name.
