Available Properties List

Displays a list of the properties available in your user control.

Available Property Pages

Contains Property Pages as tabs where you place the properties you want on each Property Page. There is one tab per property page listed on the previous screen.

- To make a Property Page active, click the appropriate tab.
- To place properties on the active Property Page, select the property or properties you want and either click one of the buttons described below or drag the property or properties to the appropriate Property Page.

Note You can drag a property to any of the Property Pages tab to place it on that property page.
