Fix bugs with printers ... Fix bug with the second CD image ... Gradient editor. Enhanced text Editor. Save your CD as Bitmap. Insert title. Fix major bugs. Fix problems with English OS. I test if a comma or a point is entered. Now you can use Text editor to write on your CD label. You can convert JPG to BMP file format.

<u>Help</u>

Center the two images on the sheet is easy thing, but it is more difficult to center them with precision, when they should be printed on a self-adhesive sheet (the problem does not arise on a simple white sheet that you will cut out with the hand) it is more difficult. It was necessary for me " to waste " 6 sheets before obtaining a perfect result (Check your printing by transparency to compare).

There is no miracle solution, the self-adhesive sheets for CD are legions and measurements are different each time. Printer have different margins, it will thus be necessary for you to show a little patience and intelligence before any final impression.

<u>File - Printer</u>

- 1 To load your printer setup.
- 2 –
- 3 To print directly

4 - To gauge the printer in order to print with precision on your sheet (ex: self-adhesive special sheet)

- 5 To record your current configuration to re-use it later
- 6 Stretching of the image. (In pixel)

Image N°1 et Image N°2

You can center your images in order to print them with precision on your sheet. X corresponds to horizontal and Y to the vertical.

Options

1 - To choose the format of its page (only one format available for the moment)

- 2 To choose the part of CD to be printed :
 - CD (corresponds to the round surface of CD)
 - CD BOX BACK (corresponds to the back)
 - CD BOX FRONT ...

3 - Choose your printer.

<u>Note</u>

From one printer to another, the margins are different, it is necessary for you initially to make a test of impression with the option CALIBRATION OF PRINTER. If the surface of printing too small or too large, use the STRETCHING.
