Lists the nodes in the console tree.

To view the nodes under any node on the console tree click the node in **Snap-ins added to**. The nodes under the selected node are displayed below **Snap-ins added to**.

Displays the nodes in **Snap-ins added to** under the node selected.

To add a new snap-in in the console tree at this level, click **Add**. To display the nodes under a node, double-click the node.

Click to add a new snap-in in **Snap-ins added to** under the node selected.
