

## Microsoft Exchange Server Tab

Specifies options for sending an active message.

### **Send This Item**

Specify when you want to send the message.

#### **Immediately**

Sends the message with no delay.

#### **In**

Sends the message after the amount of time you specify. Type a number in the first box, and then select a time increment in the second box. Delayed messages are immediately sent to your Outbox, which stores them for the specified time. If you are working offline, delayed messages are immediately sent to the Microsoft Exchange Server computer which stores them for the specified time.

### **Expire This Item**

Specify when you want the message to expire. Only unread items are affected by the expiration time you specify.

#### **Never Expire This Item**

Retains the message with no time limit.

#### **In**

Retains the message for the amount of time you specify. Type a number in the first box, and then select a time increment in the second box. After the time you specify, the message will be deleted from the Microsoft Exchange Server computer.

## **Internet Tab**

Specifies format options for an attachment.

### **Attachment Format**

#### **Don't Know**

Select this option if you don't know the attachment format.

#### **MIME**

Select this option if the attachment is in MIME format.

#### **UUEncode**

Select this option if the attachment is in UUEncode format.
