Sit back and see history unfolding before you!

iscovery Channel's World War II Suite gives macro and micro view of the War. Comprising three titles, London Blitz to Pearl Harbour, Midway to Hiroshima and Normandy-The Great Crusade, the suite unfolds the war with vivid multimedia effects.

Boot your PC, load the title London Blitz to Pearl Harbour and take off. The olive-green instrument

panel interface with a clearly defined menu lets you explore the CD through six different topics. Navigation buttons allow you complete control over the exploration. You can move back and forth with ease; zoom in and out of any part of a picture and move 360 degrees within the display window with arrow keys or the mouse.

Closely examine the Tomahawks, the RAF Hurricanes, the Luftwaffes and 720 other planes from all angles in 3D. Zoom into any part and examine every minute detail. Check the weapons and ammunitions. Move on to inspect the airfields rendered in virtual reality.

Once you know the logistics, browse through the animated maps and the war strategies via interactive 3D graphics, realistic sound effects, archival photos, historic film footage and voice-over narration. Smoothly animated air combat tactics reveal how the pilots used their planes' capability to gun down the enemy. The tumultuous journey to Pearl Harbour excites you to ask for more.

Midway to Hiroshima has the same menu and interface as the first CD. As you manoeuvre through title, you can feel the agony and glory of the Germans, the British, the Russians, the French, the Canadians and the Americans. Take a break and read through the chronology of events to make the rest of the exploration more meaningful.

And if you just want to relax, get a bowl



of peanuts, load the third CD, find the autopilot button, and switch it 'on' for over 40 minutes of compelling video. Video clips appear along with a dramatic narration of the Allied Force closing in on the Germans.

And if you want action, slide behind the controls and take off with three flight stimulators (available in all three CDs). Pick a fighter plane of your

choice and bomb the Nazis. But be careful with the controls and other fighters shooting at you or you could end up as a Kamikaze! Give full throttle, gear up, put out the flaps, zip through the sky... but wait a minute!

This is war. Not a game. Millions of people met gory death in the prime of their youth. This is a war that was fuelled by greed, hatred and fear. The brilliantly executed CDs inadvertently appeal to the same instinct that appeals to the fans of WWF wrestling. The developers have captured the facts and mechanics of the War, but have failed to bring out the human aspects.

The most unpardonable omission in the suite is the Holocaust—not a single mention of the mass murdering of millions of Jews in concentration camps. While technology is allowing you to learn history with utmost ease and interest, take care. Because in war, nobody wins.
