

Define Home Page and Photo Attributes

Purpose

Associate an optional Home Page with this object
Associate an optional Photo image with this object
Remove a previously defined Home Page from this object
Remove a previously defined Photo image from this object

Important: Once home page and photo are added to this object, you need to repeat the process of selecting a home page and/or photo if the content of the home page or the photo is changed.

Screen options

Select Home Page brings up the standard Windows Open File dialog box to let you browse and select a home page.

Remove Home Page will remove a previously defined home page from this object. This button will be disabled if no home page has been defined.

Home page file name shows the last location of the file that was selected for this object.

Select Photo brings up the standard Windows Open File dialog box to let you browse and select a photo.

Remove Photo will remove a previously defined photo from this object. This button will be disabled if no photo has been defined.

Photo file name shows the last location of the photo that was selected for this object.

Web Publishing

Purpose

To give or take away users ability to publish Web documents through the ~username mechanism.

Screen Options

Checking the **Enable Web publishing for this user** will give the [Public] trustee Read rights to this users Home Directory property.

Checking the **Disable Web publishing for this user** will remove Read rights from the users Home Directory property for the [Public] trustee.

The **Users Web directory relative to the home directory** is the subdirectory which will hold documents, images, and other files to be published. If **Enable Web publishing for this user** is selected, the [Public] trustee will be given Read and File Scan rights to this directory. If **Disable Web publishing for this user** is selected, the Read and File Scan rights will be removed from the [Public] trustee for this directory. This is a required field.

Web Publishing

Purpose

To give or take away the ability for all users in this group to publish Web documents through the ~username mechanism.

Screen Options

Checking the **Enable Web publishing for all members of this group** will give the [Public] trustee Read rights to users Home Directory property.

Checking the **Disable Web publishing for all members of this group** will remove Read rights from the users Home Directory property for the [Public] trustee.

The **Users Web directory relative to the home directory** is the subdirectory which will hold documents, images, and other files to be published by the users. If **Enable Web publishing for all members of this group** is selected, the [Public] trustee will be given Read and File Scan rights to this directory for all users. If **Disable Web publishing for all members of this group** is selected, the Read and File Scan rights will be removed from the [Public] trustee for this directory. This is a required field.
