Playing Winjack

Upon starting WinJack will <u>shuffle</u> the deck of cards. Betting must be done before <u>dealing</u> the cards by using the BetBar or entering an amount directly from 0 to 100. After which you may <u>deal</u> the cards. The player then <u>hits</u> until he gets close to 21 with out going over. When the player <u>stands</u> the deal will deal his own hand. The dealer will hit on or below 16 and <u>stand</u> on or above 17. The Bet is automatically added or subtracted from the player's assets.

Using The Mouse

Stand Left-Click on any dealer card or Right-Click on any card.

SOFTWARE LICENSE

Winlack is not and has never been public domain software, nor is it free software.

Rules...

Number of Decks - Selects the number of decks to use for the next shuffle.

Reset Assets - Resets assets amount to \$1000.

5 Card Win - Upon reaching 5 cards, without busting, the Player Wins.

Pushes - Selects who wins in case of a tie.

Setup

Animation Speed - Sets the speed of screen animation. Use $\underline{1}$ for slowest to $\underline{20}$ for fastest.

3D Text - Set check mark for 3D text on screen.

AutoSize - Set check mark for WinJack to auto size during splits

Colored Text - Colors ScoreBar text.

ScoreBar - Selects type of ScoreBar (WinJack must be restarted to reflect change).

Surrender

This is just like giving up and you'll lose half your bet. You can only surrender at the start of the hand.

DoubleDown

At the start of the hand you have the option of doubling your bet and taking one and only one additional card.

Split

You can split your hand when you are first dealt two cards of the same value. This then gives you 2 hands to play with while risking the bet amount with each hand. You can only play one hand at a time (the top hand MUST be played first). Once you stand or bust on the top hand the next card will be dealt to the second hand.
