1INTRODUCTION

Exlife is a program for extending features of MS Exchange Client (MS Windows Messaging) for Windows 95 / Windows NT 4.0.

This version add to MSEC filters (online and offline inbox assistant for incoming and outgoing messages) and signature.

ExLife is a Shareware product:

You have the opportunity to try the program 30 days at no charge to see if it meets your needs. If you continue to use the program after evaluation, please complete the included registration form

(order.doc) and send it with the applicable registration fee to the author.

Features:

- Filter current message folder. Items are moved to different folders by defined conditions. You can choose from as many types of filter as you define.
- Automatic filter incoming messages after delivery.
- Automatic filter after reading non-read messages.
- Archiving of outgoing messages into defined folders controlled by conditions (works
 only in "offline transferring internet mail mode", not in "scheduled mode" or "remote
 mail mode").
- Unlimited number of user defined filter condition.
- It's possible to filter by these mail items: From, To, CC, Subject and Message.
- 3 methods of comparison Items and entered values: FullString, SubString and Prefix.
- Append signature to end of mail.
- Support for multiple exchange profiles.

Environment:

- Windows 95, Windows NT
- MS Exchange Client / Windows Messaging (provided with Windows 95/NT)
- MS Exchange Client for MS Exchange Server (it doesn't have to be connected to an Exchange server)

2USING THE ADD-ON

2.1 Installation

Copy the DLL *EXLIFE32.DLL* into your "\windows\system" directory.Register the DLL by double-clicking *EXLIFE32.REG* in Explorer.

2.2 Deinstallation

Exit and log out of Exchange. Start regedit, open the key

\Client

\Extensions

and delete the "LM Life Extension" tag and its value. Then delete the file *EXLIFE32.DLL* from "\windows\system".

2.3Filters

In menu "Tools.Options.Filters, Signature" you can define filters, which are used for filtering incoming and outgoing message.

2.3.1 Groups Of Filters

This form is designed for defining groups of filters. These groups are used for online and offline filtering. There are predefined three types of groups:

- After Delivery: this type is assigned for online filtering after delivery.
- After Reading: Destination of this one is online filtering after reading non-read messages.
- Copy Self: this is for online filtering after sending.

2.3.1.1 Add Button

This button creates new group of filters to set of current profile.

2.3.1.2Edit Button

This button repairs a selected group of filters.

2.3.1.3 View Button

This button shows a selected group of filters.

2.3.1.4Delete Button

The Delete button allows us to delete a selected group of filters.

2.3.1.5Online Filtering

If you mark below mentioned check box, it will be permitted online filtering feature.

- After Delivery
- After Reading
- After Sending (works only in "offline transferring internet mail mode", not in "scheduled mode" or "remote mail mode")

2.3.2 Filters Of the Group

This dialog box is made for entering filters in selected group.

2.3.2.1 New Button

The New Button create new filter to set of current group.

2.3.2.2Edit

This Button repairs a selected filter.

2.3.2.3 View

This Button views a selected filter.

2.3.2.4<u>Delete</u>

The Delete Button is for deleting a selected filter.

2.3.2.5Type Of Group

You can define a type of group. It can be:

- After Delivery
- After Reading
- After Sending
- User Defined

2.3.2.6Name Of Group

If you select "User Defined" type of group, you can enter name of this group.

2.3.2.7 Interface

• not supported yet

2.3.2.8<u>Arrows</u>

You can organize an order of filter in group. When filtering is going, filters are evaluated from up to down.

2.3.3 Items Of the Filter (Easy)

In this form you can register items of selected filter. In easy form you can only put one item.

2.3.3.1 Name Of Filter

In this field you can enter name of filter.

2.3.3.2Properties

In this field you can choose message item, which will be used for filtering.

2.3.3.3 Contain

You can select three comparison methods:

• FullString: message item and entered value have to be exactly the same

- SubString: entered value have to be contained in message item
- Prefix: message item and entered value have to the same from left to end of entered value

2.3.3.4 Value

Value, which is compared with message property.

2.3.3.5 Ignore Case

If you mark this checkbox, the filtering doesn't be case sensitive.

2.3.3.6Output Folder

You also have to select folder in which moved messages are stored.

2.3.4 Example Of Comparison Methods

2.3.4.1 Full String comparison

<u>Property (From: name)</u>	<u>Content</u>	<u>Value</u>	<u>Result</u>
MAPI-L Server	FullString	MAPI	FALSE
MAPI-L Server	FullString	MAPI-L Server	TRUE

2.3.4.2 SubString comparison

<u>Property</u> (From: name)	<u>Content</u>	<u>Value</u>	<u>Result</u>
MAPI-L Server	SubString	MAPI	TRUE
MAPI-L Server	SubString	MAPIL	FALSE

2.3.4.3 Prefix comparison

<u>Property</u> (From: name)	<u>Content</u>	<u>Value</u>	<u>Result</u>
MAPI-L Server	Prefix	MAPI	TRUE
MAPI-L Server	Prefix	Server	FALSE

2.4Defining Signature

2.4.1Signature

You can define text, which is appened to sending message, when you select "File.Send" menu item.

2.4.2 Enable Signature

When you clear this checkbox, you disable this feature. Also, you can disable this feature in the menu of a send form ("Include.Signature"). You can place this command on the toolbar, if you like.

2.5Offline filtering

First select folder, which you want to filter. Then select menu item "Tools.Filter Go" or button from toolbar to start filtering process. Now you can choose suitable group of filters, if you ha-

ve entered more than one.

2.6Online filtering

To allow this feature you have to put corresponding group of filters and mark corresponding checkbox.
