Music Label 99 (v5.02) Readme

This document covers information that will help you install and use Music Label 99. Please read this entire document.

To view this Readme file in Windows WordPad, maximize the WordPad window. To print this Readme file, open it in WordPad or another word processor, and then click Print on the File menu.

NOTE! This is just a beta version and it is not fully functional or complete.

Installation

System Requirements

To use Music Label 99, you need:

- 486/66 processor or higher (Pentium processor recommended)
- Windows 95/98 or Windows NT Workstation
- 16 MB of memory (32 MB recommended)
- 10 MB of available hard-disk space required
- Microsoft Mouse or compatible pointing device.

Special Notes and Known Problems for Installation

- At the end of an install or uninstall, you may be presented with a dialog prompting you to either restart
 Windows or exit setup. ALWAYS choose to restart Windows. Doing otherwise can result in an incomplete
 installation and make it difficult to re-install correctly.
- Music Label 99 does not support Microsoft Windows NT 3.51.
- All tables will be replaced during install so backup your present database and use then restore function.
- By using the Upgrade function all 3.x and 4.x tables from previous versions will be upgraded to v5.0 tables used in Music Label 99.
- If you get an error message running Music Label 99 telling you that a file is missing, try to search for the file at the internet and if you can't find it please contact Helpsoft to receive the missing file.

Uninstalling

Music Label 99 should be uninstalled by using the Add/Remove Programs icon in the Control Panel. Uninstalling by any other means (for example, by deleting directories or files) may cause system instabilities or problems for future installation of this product.

If you use "Add/Remove Programs" to remove Music Label 99, you will have to restart Windows (95, 98 and NT). You will not be prompted to insert your CD.

- The structure of the tables has changed between version 4.x and 5.0 but 4.x (and 3.x) tables can be imported to version 5.0 by using the Upgrade-function.
- A standalone CD-Controller is included in this version. This CD-Controller can be activated as your default CD-player by following the step-by-step instructions found in the helpfile in the CD Controller page.
- If you have multiple CD-drives; add the drive name (e.g. H:) as a parameter in the shortcut path (e.g. "...\ musiclabel.exe H:"). Contact Helpsoft for more information and help.
