- If you use a Netscape, or Internet Explorer, Mplayer configured your browser automatically during installation. (Netscape help application for MPI files is MpNscape.exe. All others use mplaunch.exe.)
- If you are not using one of these browsers, you must configure your browser to work with Mplayer. To do this, add a new MIME type with mplaunch.exe as the default viewer for the MPI file type.

- Step 3 Find someone to play with.
- Step4 Launch a game.

Web Browsers

Web browsers provide a graphical interface to a rich variety of information and services on the Internet. By way of hypertext links between pages of information, you can use a web browser to surf across numerous computer sites located around the world. Mplayer works with any web browser but is optimized for use with Netscape.

World Wide Web

The World Wide Web is an Internet-based virtual universe where you can do many things, like play multiplayer games and make new friends. To access the World Wide Web you need Internet access and a web browser.

After you have access, you can go to any web site, by entering or pasting its World Wide Web address into the web browser address or URL box. Web site addresses begin with http://. For example, http://www.mplayer.com/ is the web site address for Mplayer.
