This MS Windows solitaire card game is a shareware program. I based this game on my shareware program "Pyramid!!! v2.0a" for the Apple Macintosh. The Macintosh version is a well known and popular program. This MS Windows version is in many ways superior to the Macintosh version.

Test your skill at this innovative game. The game randomly generates a pyramid of cards that you must attempt to clear away. Available cards are "matched" (total 13). The object of play is to clear away all of the cards in the pyramid. With the default seven rows, it is quite difficult to win the game. Using the Options Menu, reduce the pyramid to 6 rows to make winning easier.

The distribution files are: PYRAMID.EXE PYRAMID.HLP QCARD.DLL README.WRI <- this file

QCARD.DLL should be placed in the \WINDOWS\SYSTEM subdirectory. Although, PYRAMID.EXE will run if QCARD.DLL is in the same subdirectory as PYRAMID or in your PATH. QCARD.DLL is a freeware DLL programmed by Stephen Murphy.

You will also need VBRUN300.DLL. This DLL is required to run programs created by Visual Basic version 3.0. VBRUN300.DLL is commonly available on most bbs's and commercial on-line services (in MSBASIC forum on CompuServe). VBRUN300.DLL also belongs in the \WINDOWS\SYSTEM subdirectory.

If you enjoy this game, the shareware registration fee is **\$5.00** (or whatever you feel it is worth). Feel free to pass this game along to others.
