

Introduction

MIDI JukeBox NT allows you to select and play multiple MIDI and/or .WAV files. Files can be selected with the Open command, by using the File Manager's drag-and-drop feature, or by associating files with MIDI JukeBox.

Files can be played once or in a continuous loop.

Required Hardware and Software

MIDI JukeBox NT requires Microsoft Windows NT (October Beta or later) and a compatible MIDI output device. MIDI JukeBox NT supports the SoundBlaster Pro.

Installing the Program

Using the MS-DOS shell, or the Windows File Manager, create a subdirectory for the program. For example:

```
MKDIR C:\MIDIJB
```

Then copy all files from the distribution disk into the subdirectory. For example:

```
COPY A:\*.* C:\MIDIJB
```

The program is made up of the following files: MIDIJB.EXE, MIDIJB.HLP, and USERS_GD.WRI.

Using the Windows Program Manager, select the File menu and the New submenu. Then select the Personal Program Group button and the OK button. Enter MIDI JukeBox NT in the Description field and select the OK button.

Select the File menu and the New submenu again. This time, select the Program Item button and the OK button. Enter MIDI JukeBox NT in the Description field, and enter the location of the program in the Command Line field, for example:

```
C:\MIDIJB\MIDIJB.EXE
```

Select the OK button.

The program is now installed.

Running the Program

After starting the program, if you need further instructions, press F1 for help.
