AstroTime calls the United States Naval Observatory in Washington DC and (1-202-653-0351) polls the nuclear clock for GMT, which is then corrected

for local time zone. You should enter your local time variation in the PASSWORD position in the SESSION dialog box. Common time zone variations are as follows...

```
US Eastern (standard) = -5 (daylight) = -4 US Central (standard) = -6 (daylight) = -5 US Mountain (standard) = -7 (daylight) = -6 US Pacific (standard) = -8 (daylight) = -7 US Hawaii/Alaska (standard) = -10
```

AstroTime now comes with phonebook files for CrossTalk for Windows versions 1.1 & 1.2, titled astroll.xwp & astroll.xwp respectively. Place the appropriate "astro*.xwp" file in your Crosstalk phonebook directory and place the "astrotim.xwc" & "astrotim.xws" files in your Crosstalk script directory. After that, you can start AstroTime from an icon in the program manager by using the command line "xtalk.exe astroll.xwp" or "xtalk.exe astroll.xwp" depending on the version of CrossTalk you are using.

The default modem settings may be changed by canceling the call at the beginning of the dialing phase of the call and then changing the modem and any other settings accordingly. Be sure to save them with "File/Save" before you exit.
