

Although CorelDRAW is a vector-based program, you can incorporate bitmaps into your drawings.

Once imported, however, there are limitations to what you can do with bitmaps in CorelDRAW. Since a bitmap is created as a collection of arranged pixels, you cannot manipulate its individual parts, as you can with vector objects.

If you want to manipulate the bitmap in any way, you'll first need to convert it to a vector graphic using OCR-Trace.
