

To create images that display well in Web pages, you must save the image in a file format that is readable by Web **browsers**. GIF and .JPEG are the most common file formats.

When you publish to HTML, you have the choice to save the graphic in the **.GIF** or **.JPEG** format. CorelDRAW creates an HTML document that contains the reference to the **.GIF** or **.JPEG** bitmap and any URL (Uniform Resource Locator) information that you've assigned to graphics.
