To create images that display well in Web pages, you must save the image in a file format that is readable by Web browsers. GIF and .JPEG are the most common file formats.

When you publish to HTML, you have the choice to save the graphic in the .GIF or .JPEG format. CoreIDRAW creates an HTML document that contains the reference to the .GIF or .JPEG bitmap and any URL (Uniform Resource Locator) information that you've assigned to

graphics.
