If you've followed the steps so far, you'll have created a basic Fish Eye lens that uses the default rate setting of 100%. This setting controls the percentage by which the lens magnifies and distorts the objects behind it. You can set values from -1000 to 1000. Positive numbers create a lens that magnifies objects as it distorts them.

 Select the lens with the Pick tool.

In the Lens Roll-Up, type a new value in the Rate box. 3. Click the Apply button.
