If you plan to print your work on a commercial printing press, then you'll need to send your work to a service bureau. The service bureau will image your work onto film which is then used to create printing plates. A print shop will use the printing plates to produce your final output.

Some service bureaus will allow you to send them a .CDR file. They can then set up all the printing options for you.

This Tutor will take you through the process of preparing a .CDR

file so that your service bureau won't have problems printing it.
