

You can create an image map in an **HTML** (Hypertext Markup Language) document by assigning a URL (Uniform Resource Locator) to any object in CorelDRAW.

When you finish your drawing, you need to export the file as either Corel Barista or Corel Image Map (HTML). Both formats can be read and then displayed by most browsers.

This Tutor presents some background information about Uniform Resource Locators (URL) and shows you how to assign a URL to an object.
