

A browser is software that displays **HTML** documents and graphics. The browser reads the HTML documents and displays the information between the tags according to the specifications set by the tags.

To create a document that Web browsers can read and display, you need to create an HTML document. You can create an HTML document by typing in the HTML codes manually in any text editor, using a Web authoring tool, such as Corel Web.DESIGNER, or using software with filters that

automatically insert HTML codes when you save it, such as CoreIDRAW.
