GEOGRAPHY

RIVERS:

The Brahmaputra runs mainly through Bangladesh. It is one of the great rivers of southern Asia. It flows from south-western Tibet, through India into Bangladesh. Here it empties itself into the bay of Bengal.

The Orinoco runs through Venezuela. It is one of South America's longest rivers, with a length of about 2,560 kilometres. Christopher Columbus first sighted the river in 1498.

The Ebro runs through Spain. It rises in the Cantabrian mountains and empties into the Mediterranean Sea after a southeastern course of about 750 kilometres.
