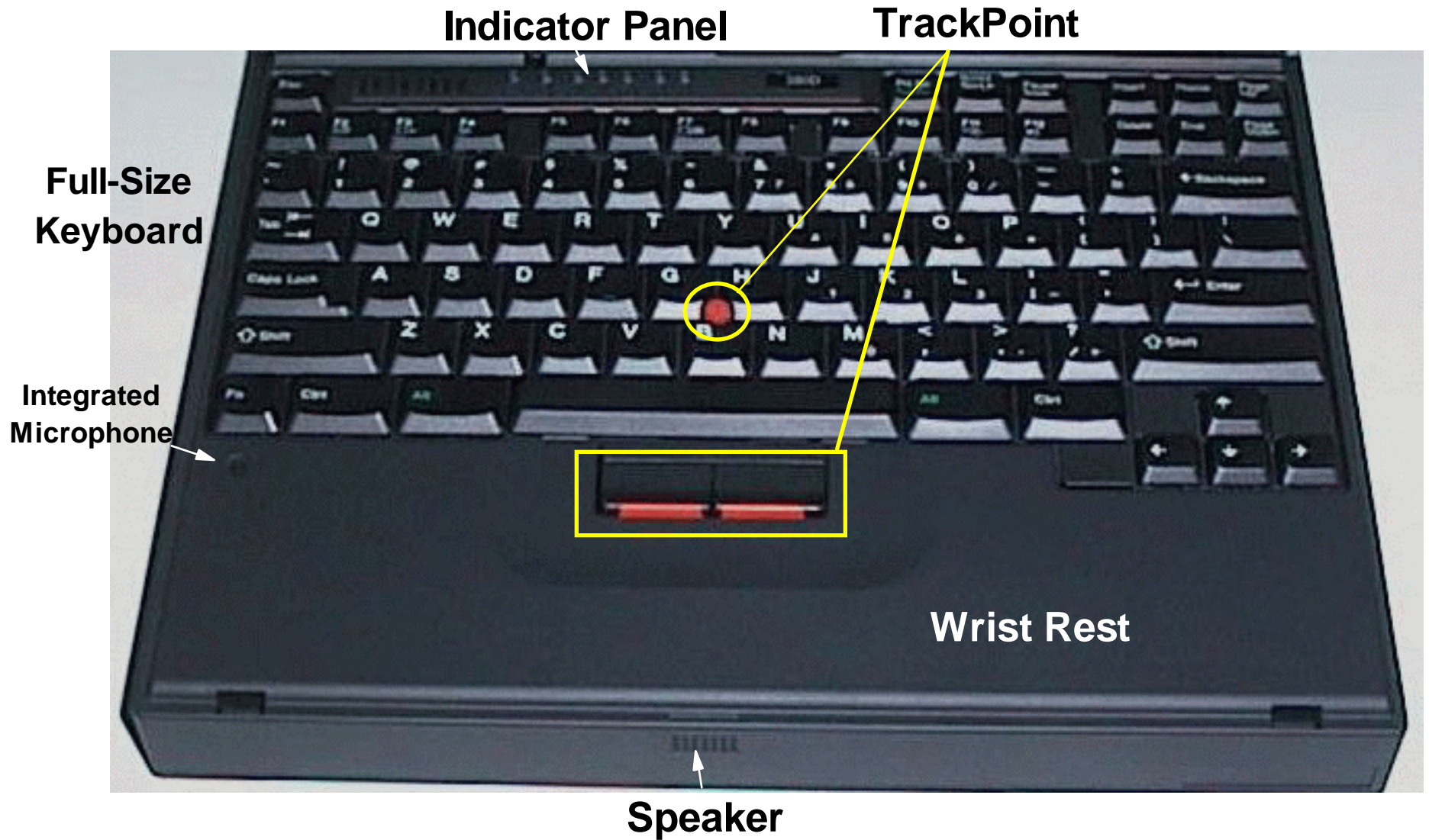

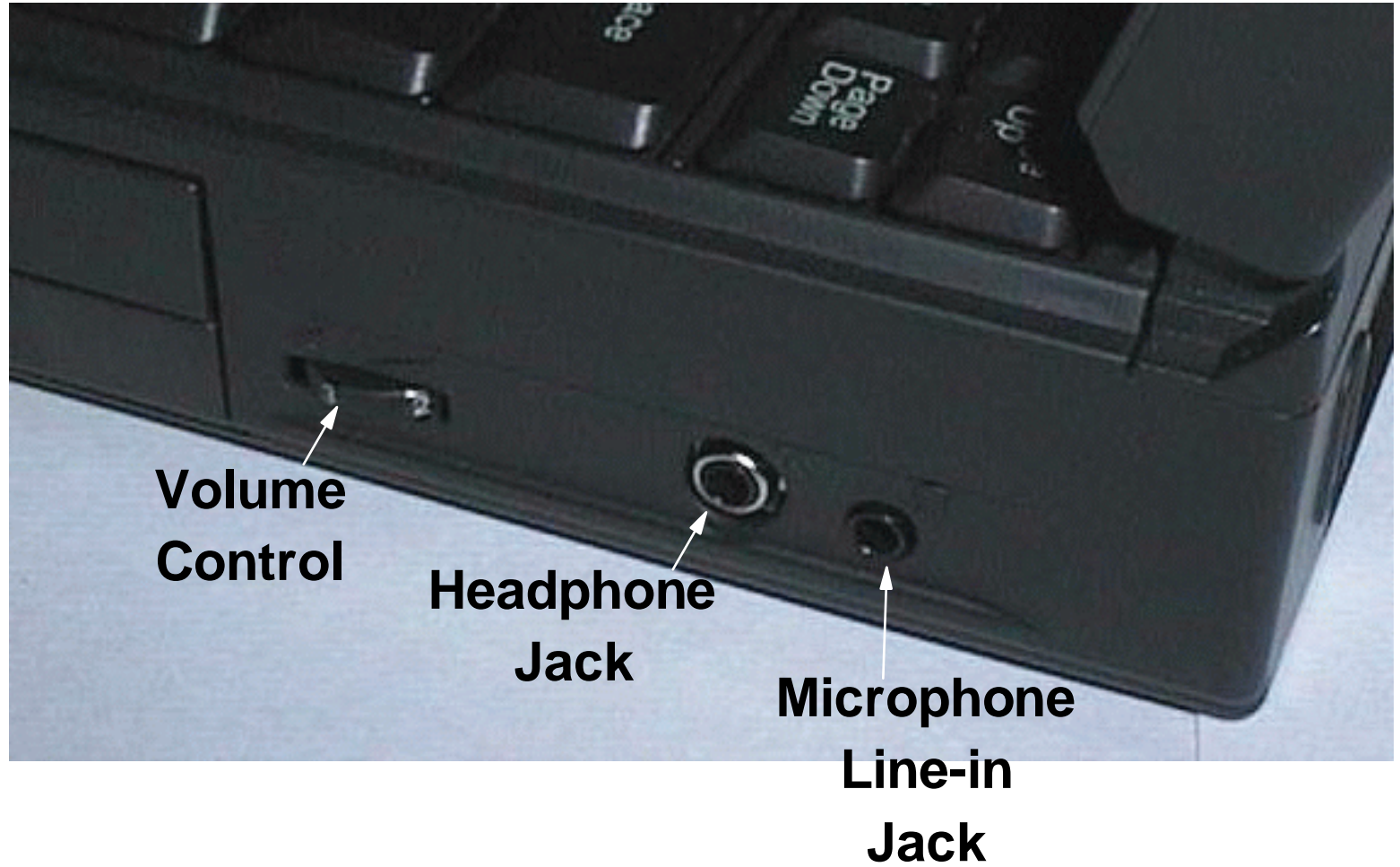

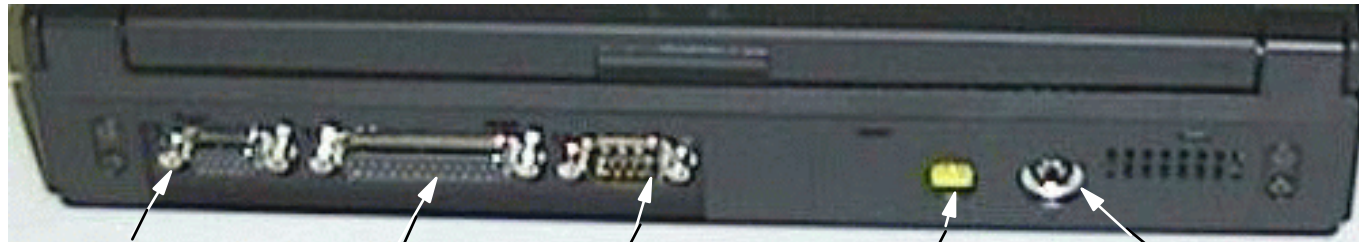

2. Lift and remove battery.

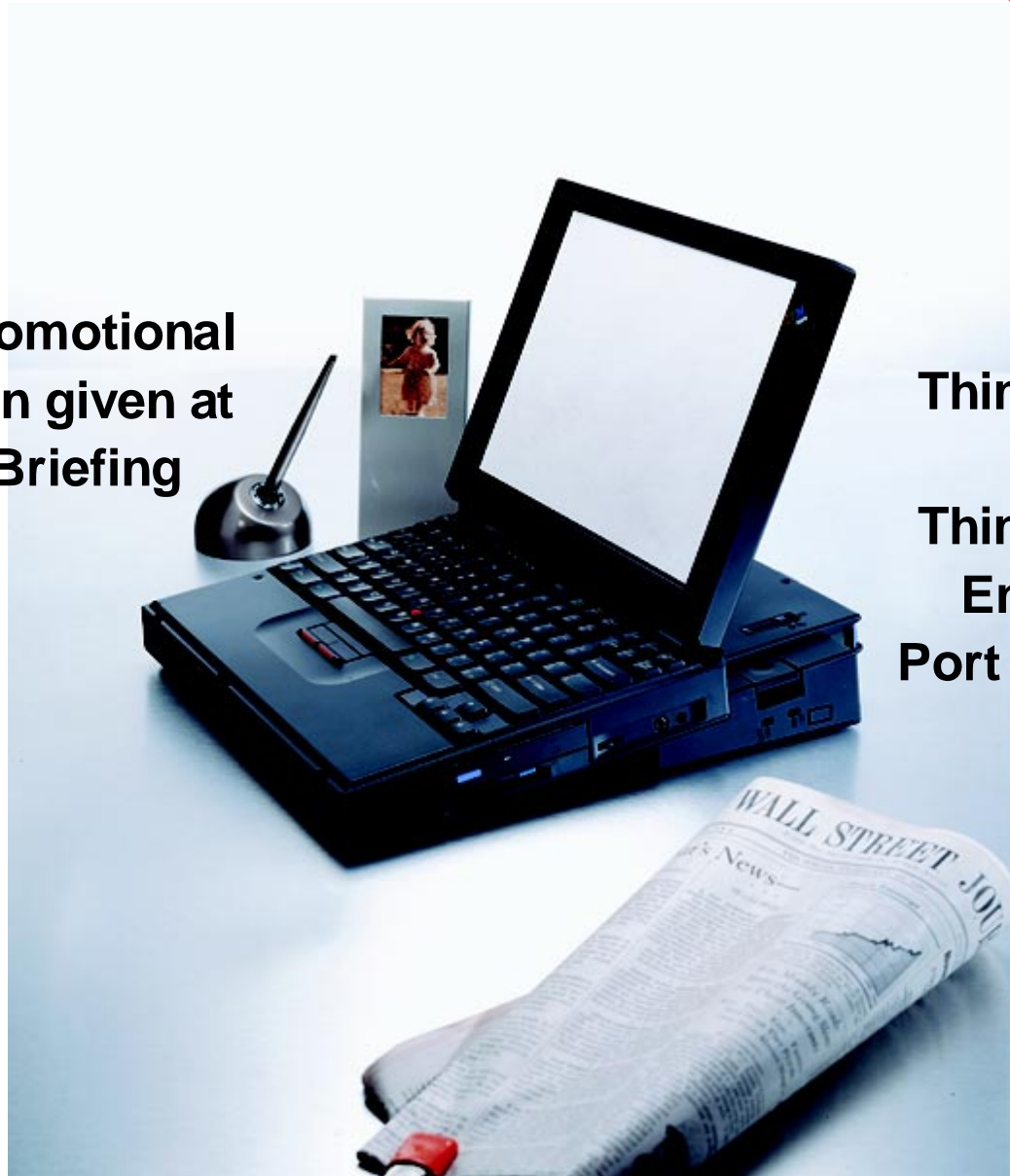

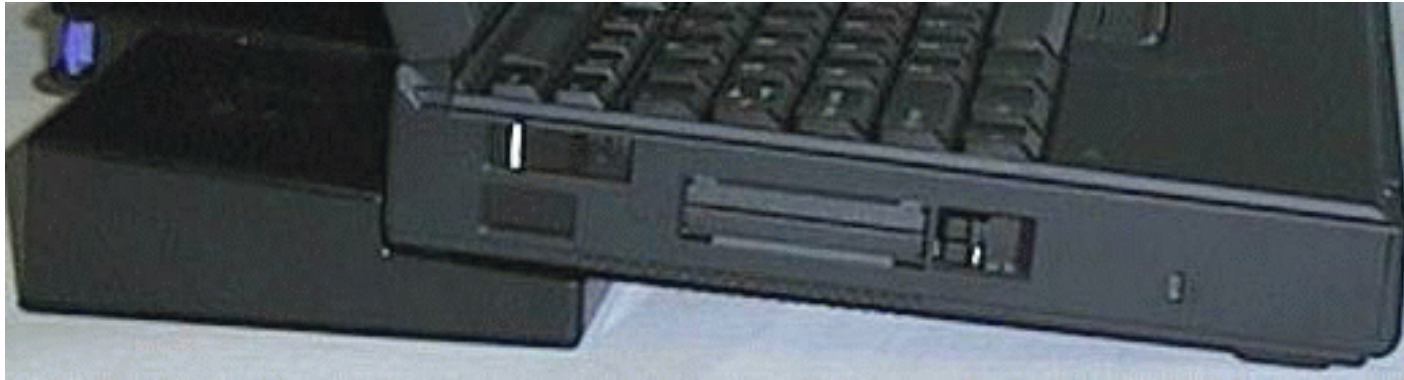

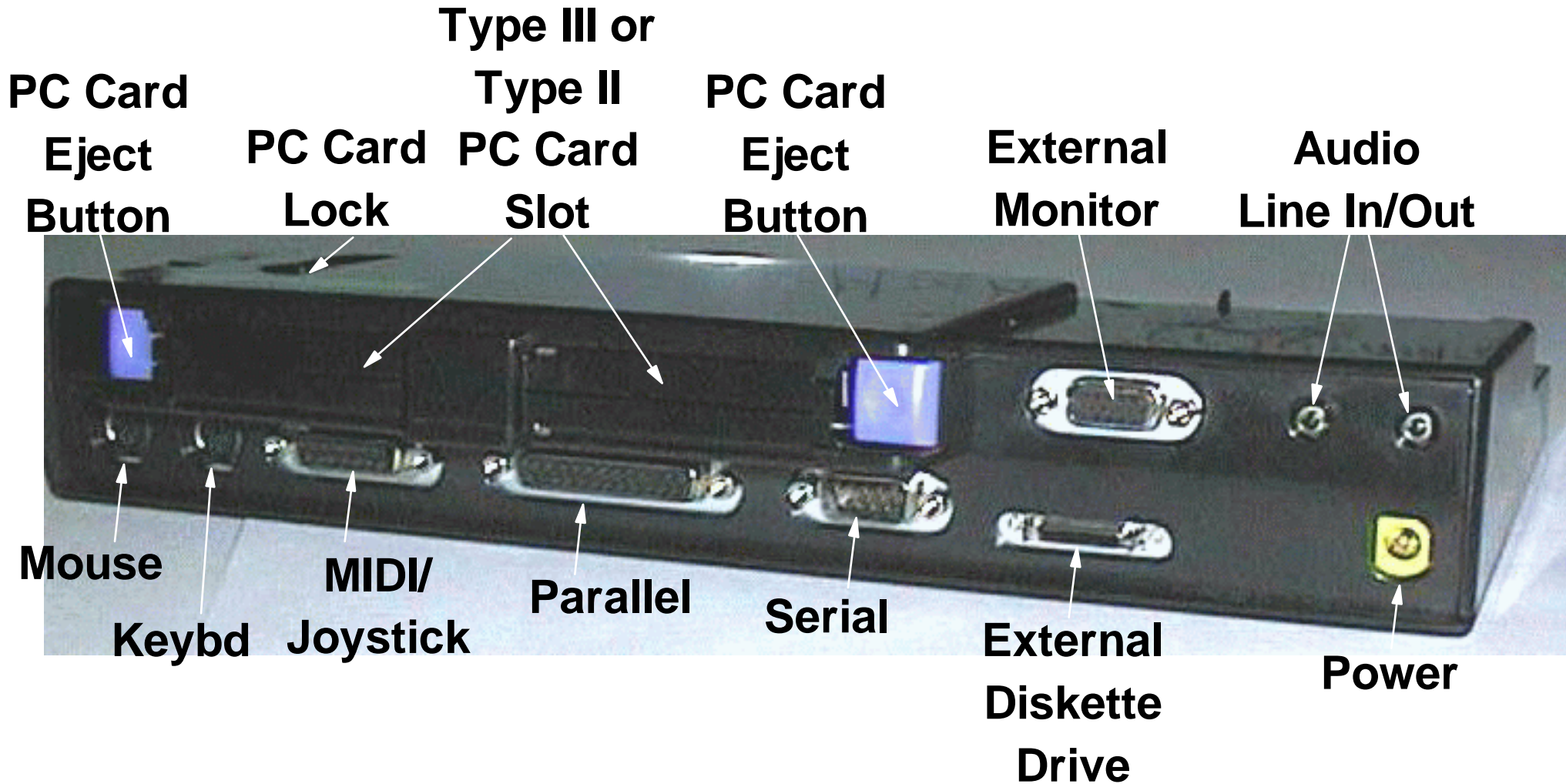
