Getting Started

Each <u>SoftwareVAULT</u> collection contains the finest programs on a given subject. To help you evaluate this software, we have included the <u>SoftwareVAULT Librarian</u> program. This is a program that will

- 1 Let you test and examine programs in the <u>SoftwareVAULT</u> collection.
- 2 Help you find programs of interest.
- 3 Help you setup these programs on your hard drive if you wish.

The files on the CD-Rom are not compressed and many may be run directly from the CD-Rom

If a program can be run directly from the CD-Rom, the "RUN" button will be enabled.

If a program can be run directly from the Hard Disk, the "INSTALL and RUN" button will be enabled.

If a program needs to be installed on the Hard Disk BEFORE it can be run, the "SETUP" button will be enabled.

If there is a special text file that you should read before installing or running the program, , the "INFORMATION" button will be lit.

How To Use the Files on This CD-Rom.

You can use any of the programs and resources on a <u>SoftwareVAULT</u> Collection with just a few easy steps...

Step 1

Find and select a program or resource you'd like to use. Locate the collection or program of interest. As you browse the list of items, you will notice the description changing to explain what the current item is about. Once you find one something of interest, you have several options.

Step 2

There are several buttons on the botton of the window. One or more of the buttons may be enabled. If the *SETUP* button is active, that means that you can install the program to your hard drive. If the *RUN* button is not enabled, you must setup the program on the hard disk before you can ru it. If the *RUN* button is enabled, you can run the program directly from the CD-ROM. If the program you're interested in is designed for DOS, it may be necessary to exit Windows and run the program directly from DOS.

Step 3

Enter the drive and directory in which to put your file. If the directory does not exist, the <u>SoftwareVAULT</u> Librarian create this directory for you. In most cases, the Librarian will suggest a directory name for you. If the program is DOS, make a note of where you create your directory so you can find it once the <u>Librarian</u> is finished!

Step 4

Run the program. If the *RUN* button is active, just click on it to run the program. If you had to install the program to your hard disk and it was a windows program, a Program Manager Group and an *ICON* will have been created for you. if you selected a DOS program (like a game) then after copying the files to your hard disk, exit the <u>Librarian</u> and go to the directory you created for your files. To start the program, look for the file with a ".exe" on the end of it's name. This is the main executable file for your program. Execute this file. If your program is a Windows program, double-click on the new *ICON* in your new program group.

Text Menu

The text files contain information on how the <u>SoftwareVAULT</u> collections are assembled and how you can register <u>shareware</u> programs requiring registration. You will also find information about <u>Digital Impact</u>, the copyrights on the <u>Librarian</u>, warranties and Technical Support. There is also information about the virus precautions we take and the utilities we use.

Controls

The <u>SoftwareVAULT</u> <u>Librarian</u> is equipped with a set of controls that makes using the <u>Librarian</u> quick and easy.



This button will select a new collection A list of all available collections will be displayed for you to choose from.



This button displays the Text list. Information about <u>shareware</u>, out warranty, copyrights, the <u>SoftwareVAULT</u> and the <u>Digital Impact</u> Story are all here. Read down the list one at a time if you wish. This is also where you will find Technical Support information. After you have finished reading the text, you will find that the book has been replaced with a picture of a CD-ROM. (see next item)



When this picture replaces the book, it means that you can click on it and you will be returned to your prior selection.



Clicking this button will get you Help in a hurry. The help system also contains a complete tutorial on how to use the Librarian.



Clicking your mouse on this button will close the <u>Librarian</u> and return you to the Windows Program Manager.

The <u>Librarian</u> also has a set of buttons at the bottom of the screen. These buttons perform the following functions.



Clicking your mouse on this button will run setup to install the program you selected on your hard drive.



Clicking your mouse on this button will run the selected program directly from the CD-Rom. This button may not be enabled on some programs.



Clicking your mouse on this button will show any special information relating to the program you selected.

This button may not be enabled on some programs.



Clicking your mouse on this button will print the information in the text window. This button will work on any selection.

This displays the name that the window is called. It is common to the Microsoft Windows Operating System.

Extension

The part of the filename that comes after the period. For example, if the file was called "MYNAME.EEE", the "EEE" would be the extension.

Groups

A Group may contain references to one or more Areas or Categories. If a Group button on the main window is "grayed out", it means that there are no files or Areas that apply to that collection.

LibrarianThis is the Files Manager designed for and used by the SoftwareVAULT collections.

Shareware

Shareware software is a unique marketing approach which allows you to purchase software directly from the author. This eliminates costly marketing, promotion, and packaging; allowing you to obtain quality software at a fraction of the commercial cost. You are encouraged to examine a program, copy it, and pass it on to friends. If you find the software program useful, you are asked to register with the software author. This usually means paying a registration fee directly to the shareware author. In return for this registration fee, you receive the right to continue to use the software and added benefits such as full documentation, technical support, and future updates of the program. This is the Try-Before-You-Buy concept.
