### **INSTALLING TRUETYPE FONTS**

Installation of a TrueType font with System 7 is simple. Drag the TrueType suitcase to your System Folder and drop it in. That's it! You may load your application to start using the new font.

You may also double-click the suitcase before installing to see a preview of the new font.

**NOTE**: IF YOU ARE USING SYSTEM 6 YOU WILL NEED TO ACQUIRE THE TRUETYPE INIT FROM APPLE.



### INSTALLING TYPE 1 FONTS

System 7 users, copy the Type 1 icons to your System Folder. System 7 will place all the files in the correct folders.

**System 6** users will need to copy the printer icon to the System Folder. To install the suitcase will require Font/DA Mover to copy the screen fonts to your System file.




To use these with either System 6 or 7, copy the System Extension, CDEV, or Apple Menu Items (Desk Accessory) to your System Folder and reboot.

**EXTENSIONS** work a bit differently. When you restart your Mac, they stay resident in memory to perform a certain function. To obtain instructions on a particular Extension please read through any document file included. **Note:** If you have moved an Extension and it is not loading when you restart your Mac, verify that it is selected, using the Extension Manger Extension.

**APPLE MENU ITEMS** are accessed by pulling down the Apple Menu and selecting it. System 6 users will have to use Font/DA Mover to add the DA to there System file.



Using HyperCard stacks is as easy as *double-clicking* . If you receive an error message similar to the following:



you do not have either HyperCard or the HyperCard Player installed on your system.




