

Willie Worm Math 1.0

Thank you for downloading Willie Worm Math version 1.0. First of all, Willie Worm Math is **FREEWARE**, so copy it and distribute it, use it in your home, in your school, in your church -- wherever and whenever you need an arithmetic drill.

Design Note: The answers you type in fill the answer box from right to left (which is how you would figure out most of the answers to the problems if you were doing it on paper), so keep this in mind when you have a problem like $5 + 5$. If you type 10, the answer box will read 01 and Willie Worm will continue to inch across the screen, waiting for the correct answer. This is a bit of an inconvenience, but will be corrected in a future version. Although inconvenient for simple math problems, the right-to-left feature comes in handy when completing problems like 35×7 , because it allows you to type in first the 5 (of 35, the product of 5×7), making it easier to carry the 3 and complete the problem.

How To Play:

When the introductory screen pops up, click the "Go To Math" button. Willie Worm Math 1.0 opens with Addition. To enter an answer, either type it in the yellow box using the number keys on your keyboard, or click the numbers on the on-screen keypad that correspond to your answer. Once your answer is placed into the yellow box, click the "Am I Right?" button or press enter to see if your answer is correct. If your answer is incorrect, you may continue to enter answers until Willie Worm disappears from view, at which time the correct answer will be placed in the yellow box by Willie Worm.

Options:

Use the option buttons at the bottom left of the screen to switch to subtraction, multiplication, or division.

To select a difficulty level, click either Level 1, Level 2, or Level 3. Level 1 (the easiest level) is the default.

To enable or disable the beeping sound Willie the Worm makes as he scoots across the screen, select either Sound ON or Sound OFF at the bottom right corner of the screen. The default is Sound OFF.
