1.2 Introduction

Audible Illusions CDP is a CD-ROM compact disc player. It was written to operate just like a home stereo CD player. It was also written to replace all other CD players and does so quite easily. Audible Illusions CDP is by far the best, most complete compact disc player available.

It can be started in WBStartup and iconified so it is always available.

1.3 System Requirements

This program requires at least version V39 of the operating system software. This is to take advantage of the new commands and new tags. It is now easy enough to update your system so it should not pose a problem.

This program requires less than 512K of RAM, therefore it should operate on all systems.

A CD-ROM drive is required to play CDs.

To use the full potential, a harddrive is recommended but not required.

1.5 Starting Audible Illusions CDP

This program may be started from the Workbench or the Shell window.

This program will detach from the Shell so you need not use Run or any other variant. There are a few command line arguments you may use when loading:

SCIS DEVICE/K Name of the SCSI device in your system. ex: SCSI_DEVICE=gvpscsi.device. default: scsi.device ADDRESS/K Address of your CD-ROM drive. ex: ADDRESS=4 default: 3 LUN/K Logical Unit Number to use for CD changers ex: LUN=6 default: 0 CD_LIST_PATH/K Path to save CD information. ex: CD_LIST_PATH=Work:AICDP/ default: PROGDIR: SMALL_UI/K Toggle use of small or full user interface

ex: SMALL_UI=TRUE default: FALSE SMALL X/K X coordinate for small user interface ex: SMALL_X=100 default: 0 SMALL_Y/K Y coordinate for small user interface ex: SMALL_Y=100 default: 12 AUTOPLAY/K Toggle auto-playing of CD when inserted. ex: AUTOPLAY=TRUE default: TRUE **ICONIFY/S** Start in iconified mode. ICON_X/K X coordinate for AppIcon. ICON_Y/K Y coordinate for AppIcon. PUBSCREEN/K Name of public screen to open the interface on. LANGUAGE/K Preferred locale strings language. Language must be all lower case. DONOTDETACH/S Do not detach from the Shell. The arguments are not case sensitive and may be mixed in any order. ex: AudibleIllusionsCDP SCSI_DEVICE=gvpscsi.device ADDRESS=3 SMALL_UI=TRUE Only one copy may be run at one time. You will be notified if more than one copy is attempted to be executed.

1.6 Menu Strip

Preferences... Open the preferences window. Iconify Iconify the program and place an AppIcon on the default public screen. About... Will open a large requester with some pertinent information about the program. Quit Will terminate the program.

1.7 Main Editor

Continue Normal play mode. Program Play tracks specified in the program list. Shuffle Randomly play tracks. Repeat Repeat tracks when get to the end. Preview Play the first 15 seconds of each track. Edit Songs Open Edit Songs editor to edit CD data. Edit Program Open Editor Program editor to create/edit a program list. Small UI Switch to the small user interface Quit Terminate the program.

1.8 Preferences Editor

SCSI Device Name of your SCSI device. Address Address of CD-ROM drive. LUN Logical Unit Number for CD-changers. CD List Path Path to save compact discs. Small UI Use small user interface. X Coordinate X coordinate of small interface. Y Coordinate Y coordinate of small interface. Auto Play Automatically play CD when inserted.

Load Load preferences. Close Close Preferences editor. Save Save preferences.

1.9 **Edit Songs Editor**

Artist/Group. Title of the CD. Songs CD song list. Name of current song. Add or remove song from default play list. This allows you to not play songs you don't like without making a program list. Re-load disc data. Close the editor. Save the disc data.

Song List

Click on the titles in the listview gadget to add it to the Program List. Songs may be added in any order and there is no maximum number of entries.

Program List

Click on the titles in the listview gadget to remove an entry.

Close

Close the editor.

Clear

Clear the list.

1.11 Using Audible Illusions CDP Converter

This program will convert all your individual CD ID files into one huge file and name it AICDP_CD_List.Old. You should then use the Editor and merge your AICDP_CD_List.Old list with the supplied list.

1.12 Using Audible Illusions CDP Editor

The Editor is a full-featured CD ID editing program. You can see every CD in the list, edit tracks, remove CDs, and scan in new CDs. The Merge feature is very useful if find another AICDP_CD_List that has some new CDs.

The basic operation is the same as the main player program.

1.13 GadTools

Thanks to Olaf `Olsen' Barthel, author of gtlayout.library. It is by far the best user interface package.

The user interface is totally font and screen mode sensitive. All gadgets and the window will automatically adjust to match your preferences.

The latest features are utilized to get the most from the operating system and to make the program the best of it's kind.

1.14 Locale Support

This is program is totally localized to allow support for foreign languages. A catalog may not be available for your language at this time, but one will hopefully be available soon.

If you are willing to translate the strings to another language, please let me know. If you do offer, a perfect translation of all strings will be expected. It is all or nothing. I will also be seeking your assistance for future versions that have new strings.

1.15 Operation Notes

Press the Help key for AmigaGuide help.

It can be started in WBStartup and iconified so it is always available.

If a new CD is inserted, the Edit Songs editor will automatically be opened for you, but only if using the Full UI.

1.16 Hints And Tips

If you wish to place the Small UI at certain coordinates and want to save them, move the Small UI window to where you want it, open the Full UI and the window coordinates will be remembered and placed in the Preferences gadgets for easy positioning.

To make life easier for other users, I would appreciate it if you would send me a copy of all your CD IDs you save to add to my collection to distribute in the main archive. The more I receive, the less work you and everybody will have to do in the future. It is not much fun adding dozens of CDs to your library.

1.17 Reporting Bugs

I try to make sure all new additions or changes work correctly before releasing a new version, but, something might get by. If you encounter a bug or a problem with hardware or other programs, please let me know. Do not assume it will be fixed in the next version because if no one tells me, I may not find it.

Please be very specific about what the bug does, when it does it, how you found it, and how I can re-create it to test it. Also let me know what your system consists of: Kickstart version, hard-drives, memory expansion, accelerator card, chip set (original, ECS, AGA), etc.

If you find a program that is not compatible with this program, please send it to me on a disk or via electronic mail.
