1.3 Installing PowerDOORS

Installation of this PowerDOOR...

All PowerDOORS are installed in the same way. Simply, make sure that there is a directory in your Doors directory or assignment called 'POWER'. This is where all PowerDOORS are stored. If you do not have your DOORS directory assigned, then you should add an Assign to your Startup-Sequence or User-Startup File.

C:Assign >NIL: DOORS: BBS:Doors/

^^^^

Change this to your Doors directory path

Now, Create a directory inside the `DOORS:Power/' Directory with the name of the Door. This is the word to the right of the `Power' in the Archive filename. So, For example, if the PowerDOOR was called PowerACCESS, then you would create a directory in the `DOORS:Power/' directory called `ACCESS'.

Now, Locate the Archive you downloaded or received. It will probably be in the `LhA' or `LZX' form. Simply use a version of `LhA' or `LZX' to Extract the files into the desired path.

Now, all the files including some File Descriptions `File_ID.DIZ' and some Configuration files `Access.CFG'. Other files will also be included which are not Doors such as those that have the File Extension of `.Text'. These files are ANSIs. If you find a file with an extension of `DAT', then do not try and edit these.

Now, Simply add the following line to your `DOORS:IntroDoor.Text'
