This section is for people who hate reading documentation and just want to know the most important things.

So here they are:

<*> You can start BED from the
Shell
or from the
Workbench
<*> The layout of the menus, of the keyboard and the actions to ←
take
at each mouse click are called
definitions
, and are specified in
a file with the ".dfn" extension in the "BED:Support" directory.

<*> A lot of
preferences
are specified in files with ".prf"
extension in the "BED:Support" directory

<*> In the "Rexx" directory there are a lot of useful
ARexx Macros
.
They can be executed using the
ARexx menu
.

<*> At startup, if not otherwise specified, BED loads the
definitions from "
BED:Support/Startup.dfn
", the preferences from
"BED:Support/Startup.prf", and executes the ARexx Macro
"BED:Rexx/Startup.bed", if it exists.

<*> When a new window is opened, if not otherwise specified, BED
executes the ARexx Macro "BED:Rexx/Doc_Startup.bed", if it
exists. In the original configuration this macro does the same
as "BED:Rexx/SetConfig.bed", i.e. it loads the preferences and
the definitions according to the current filename extension. You
can, of course, modify or delete this macro.

1.3 Introduction

Introduction

Blacks Editor is a powerful, user-friendly, very configurable text editor.

The main features are:

* Multi-window. You can open as many windows as your memory allows.

- * Configurability. You can define the layout of the menus, the function of every keystroke, the function of every kind of mouse click. Furthermore, each window can have different definitions.
- * A lot of preferences. They are too many to list here... give BED a try and see them.
- * SAS C Support. You can easily arrange it for any other compiler or language.
- * Backup. When you save a file, a number of backups can be maintained.
- * Autosave. Your files can be automatically saved at the interval you select.
- * Advanced Icon Saving. A different icon can be saved, depending on the filename extension of your file.
- * End of Line Handling. You can easily load or save files with EOL different from LF, for example files saved on PCs.
- * Ability to use the keyboard in an IBM-style.
- * Full Localization (only for 3.0)
- * On-line AmigaGuide help (only for 3.0)
- * Optional "reqtools.library" or "asl.library" requesters.
- * Optional ARexx Macros launched at each BED start, document opening, or file opening.
- * ARexx support. There are 151 commands, usable in ARexx Macros or in the definition of menus, keystrokes and mouse clicks. The main abilities are the following:
 - Edit and Move commands
 - Standard Clipboard Function
 - Recorded Macros
 - Paragraph Formatting
 - Bookmarks
 - Find & Replace
 - Matching Brackets
 - Undo & Undelete line
 - Run external Tools, DOS Scripts, ARexx Macros
 - Encrypting
 - Open documents without a window (useful for ARexx Macros)
- * And, above all, it's made by ME.

Minor update. Some bugs fixed.

- * Another Enforcer hit removed.
- * Documents updated.
- * Created missing Startup.prf file and Moved settings submenu up one level in it.
- * Added missing Czech catalogs.

--- 1.1 - 25-Nov-97 -----

Intermediate update. Bugs fixed.

- * Development resumed by Isengard Developments.
- * Hopefully the rest of the Enforcer hits have been removed.
- * I'm sure Marco added a bunch of stuff to make it 1.1, but it is unfortunately undocumented.

Minor update. Some bugs fixed.

- * Some Enforcer Hit removed.

- * Last v39 function calls trapped. They caused BED to guru when a block was selected or a requester with cycle or palette gadgets was closed.

- * The conversion from tabs to spaces when printing has been fixed.
- * Many other minor bugs fixed.

1.25 Menu name: File

The File Menu:

New Doc

Opens a new document window.

Clear File

Clears the buffer of the current document.

Open File...

Opens a file requester, and the specified file is loaded into the current document window. If the current file has been modified, a

confirmation requester appears.

Open New Doc...

Opens a new document window and a file requester, allowing you to load a file into the new document.

Insert File...

Opens a file requester, and the specified file is loaded and inserted into the current document at the cursor position.

Save File

Saves the file with the current filename.

Save File As...

Opens a file requester, and the file is saved with the specified filename. If a file with the same filename already exists, a confirmation requester appears.

Save & Close

Saves the file with the current filename, then the document window is closed.

Print File...

Prints the current file. A confirmation requester appears.

Close Doc...

Closes the current document window.

Quit

All open document windows are closed, and the program quits.

1.26 Menu name: Window

The Window Menu:

Select...

Displays a list of all open documents, and the specified one is activated and brought to front.

Minimize

The current document window is resized to the minimum dimensions

Maximize

The current document window is resized to the maximum dimensions

Normalize

The current document window is resized to the normal dimensions (as specified by the DEFAULTWINDOW preference).

Snapshot

Saves the dimensions of the current document window as the default normal dimensions.

Iconify

Iconifies the current document window.

Iconify All

Iconifies all the document windows.

Tile

Reorganizes the windows on the screen as tiles.

Stack

Reorganizes the windows on the screen as a stack.

Cascade

Reorganizes the windows on the screen as a cascade.

Open Desktop...

Opens a file saved with "Save Desktop As...", and restores the desktop as described in the file.

Save Desktop As...

The dimension, position, and filename of all the documents are stored into the file specified with the file requester.

1.27 Menu name: Edit

The Edit Menu:

Mark Block

Mark the start of a selection block. If a block is already selected, the block is de-selected.

Select Word

The word under the cursor is selected.

Select Line

The current line is selected.

Select All

The whole document is selected.

Cut

The selected block is erased and copied into the clipboard.

Copy

The selected block is copied into the clipboard.

Paste

The contents of the clipboard is inserted at the cursor position.

Erase

The selected block is erased.

Cut Append

The selected block is erased and appended to the end of the clipboard.

Copy Append

The selected block is appended to the end of the clipboard.

Open Clip...

The specified file is loaded and inserted into the clipboard.

Save Clip As...

The contents of the clipboard is saved with the specified filename.

Print Clip...

The contents of the clipboard is printed. A confirmation requester appears.

Set Bookmark

Set the specified bookmark at the current cursor position.

Goto bookmark

Moves The cursor to the specified bookmark

1.29 Menu name: Format

The Format Menu:

Format Paragraph

The paragraph under the cursor is formatted, according to the LeftMargin, RightMargin, Indent, LeaveIndent, RightMarginWBorder preferences. This means that extra spaces or tabs between words are removed, and every line is filled with as many words as possible.

Goto paragraph - Previous/Next

Moves the cursor to the start of previous/next paragraph.

Documentize

Every paragraph of the document is put onto a single line, removing the line feeds. This command is useful before loading the file into a word processor.

Left Justify

The selected block (or the current line) is justified along the left margin, according to the LeftMargin preference.

Right Justify

The selected block (or the current line) is justified along the right margin, according to the RightMargin preference.

L/R Justify

The selected block (or the current line) is justified along both margins, according to LeftMargin and RightMargin preference. This means that spaces are inserted/removed to line up the line(s) along left and right margins.

Tabs -> Spaces

Tab characters are expanded into spaces. This command affects the selected block, or the whole document.

Spaces -> Tabs

Spaces are converted into tab characters. This command affects the selected block, or the whole document.

Remove EOL Blanks

Spaces and tab characters at the ends of lines are removed. This command affects the selected block, or the whole document.

Indent Block

A tab character is added to the start of the line(s). This command affects the selected block, or the whole document.

Unindent Block

A tab character is removed (if present) from the start of the line(s). This command affects the selected block, or the whole document.

Indent Line

A tab character is added to the start of the current line.

Unindent Line

A tab character is removed (if present) from the start of the current line.

1.30 Menu name: Extras

The Extras Menu:

Undo Line

The line is restored to what it was when the cursor was moved onto it.

Undelete Line

The last deleted line is inserted at the current cursor position.

Insert Current Date

The current date is inserted at the current cursor position.

Insert Current Time

The current time is inserted at the current cursor position.

Insert ASCII Char...

Opens a requester asking the ASCII code of the character to insert at the current cursor position.

Insert Version String

Insert a version string at the current cursor position. The filename and date are automatically inserted, you only have to insert the version number.

Comment Block

The selected block marked is as a comment. The current comment type is C-style, but you can change it modifying the "CommentBlk.bed" macro.

Number Lines

Insert the line number at the start of every line of the selected block (or of the whole document).

Word -> Lower Case

Converts the word under the cursor to lower case.

Word -> Upper Case

Converts the word under the cursor to upper case.

Toggle Char Case

Toggle the case of the character under the cursor.

Encrypt Block

Encrypt the selected block (or the whole document) with the ROT-13 algorithm. This means that it exchanges the letters A-M with the letters N-Z. Applying the encryption twice gives the original file.

1.31 Menu name: Macro

The Macro Menu:

Start Recording

Starts recording a macro. Every action will now be recorded.

Stop recording

Stops recording a macro. The macro can now be re-executed many times.

Play Macro

Executes the recorded macro once.

Play Many...

Opens a requester asking how many times to execute the recorded macro. If you enter 0, the macro will be continually executed until an error is encountered.

Open Macro...

A previously saved macro can be loaded. (Remember that you can use a saved recorded macro as an ARexx macro but, usually, not viceversa.

Save Macro As...

The recorded macro is saved as an ASCII file, which can also be executed as an ARexx macro.

Tools:**New Shell...**

Opens a new standard Amiga Shell, whose path is set as the current file path. The geometry of the window is specified by the Console preference.

New Console...

Opens a new BED console. From here you can directly enter any BED command, which is sent to the current document. The geometry of the window is specified by the Console preference.

The specified tool is executed synchronously.
