1.3 Installing Compulist v2.1

This program only works if user has simple or full ANSI support, if a user does not meet this requirement, they will receive a message alerting them of this requirement.

Installation procedures...

- (1) Load "BBSMENU" into your favorite text editor (CED is recomended!)
- (2) Locate "3; Main Prompt" and change "List" to "OLDList"
- (3) Now at the end of "3; Main Prompt" add this:

List |?#0PFiles:COMPULIST/BBS.rx}|

(4) Makedir PFiles:COMPULIST
(5) Copy the contents of COMPULIST directory to the above directory.
(6) Copy the contents of the C directory to your C directory.
(7) Load the CNet config program and select LOGS and make sure your
ArexxSays has something in the optional filename field to activate
the log file. (This step is optional)
(8) Add the following to your CONFIG/EVENTS:
RunARexx PFiles:Compulist/BBS.rx EVENT
Set it to run on each day AFTER 24:00 similar to this example:

Removed some code that was no longer needed

The [V]iew BBS Ad now displays only BBS that

have a BBS ad available.

No known bugs.

08/07/97 v1.3a Program is still shareware, but it is now the

full program (no disabled options).

When an entry was edited and the phone number

was changed and the BBS contained an ad, you

would no longer be able to view the ad because

that ad was not changed accordingly. Fixed!

Re-did guide. Used 3.1 multiview to add some

sparkles to the text.

This version took some time to release because

of family deaths, Amiga 500 also died on me,

and other roadblocks. Future releases should

be more up to date now. The 1.3a version is

meant to mean v1.3 (a)gain.;)

09/17/97 v1.4 Fixed a few minor bugs. Added my e-mail to

the [?] option. Ready to upload to Aminet.

10/27/97 v1.5 Program now optionally uses PMK's wait.rexx

program to display an animated "Hit Key"

prompt.

This may be the last upload to Aminet unless I

get some type of response from users. If I

get negative response from this version, this

will be the last public update and I will just

continue to work on it for my own use...

10/27/97 v1.5a The archive for v1.5 contained a v1.4 .readme.

Uploaded to Aminet by mistake. Fixed!

12/03/97 v1.6 Program now displays a warning message when

the user is about to upload an ad for the BBS

entry.

I placed some code in the wrong place (oops!).

When and someone wanted to have an ad for the

new bbs entry, it was not properly detected

Sorry to report that this will be the last

02/01/98 v2.0 I got my hands on an IBM compatible 486/25 and

of weird ANSI codes and the display kind of

bad. This was due to wrong ANSI codes being

used. I have hopefully fixed all of this.

Added colors to the BBS listing!

Re-worked on some routines to hopefully make

things a little bit faster.

The download function now uses CNet's internal

settings.

It is now possible for a BBS listed twice to

contain it's own ad. This was not possible

because of the method used to store the ad

file.

Included a NEW file that will be displayed for

entries that the user selects to view ad for

but there was no ad uploaded. This was done

because sometimes users enter an invalid

number at the view bbs ad prompt.

Script is a little bit smaller!

As of this version, it has been verified to

run with 68000, 68020, 68030, and 68040 with

and without FPU and MMU. I still have not

been told if it works with CNet other than

v3.05c or other CNet compatible BBS software.

01/15/99 v2.1 I decided to check the script one more time

and noticed problems in the error routines. I

have hopefully fixed the problems.

I tested this with version 4.69 of CNet and it

seems to work just fine. Please send email to
