1.2 Introduction to AppReplacelcon

A little utility I have written, because I was tired of changing the icons of all my drawers with the fonction 'Copy As' of DirOpus...

Moreover, all the tooltypes and the defaulttool were forgotten...

AppReplaceIcon was born!

AppReplaceIcon support the icons of the 'NewIcons' system !

1.3 Requirements

AppReplaceIcon is divided into two versions :

AppReplaceIcon

- The normal version for the native icons of the Workbench

AppReplaceNewIcon

- The extended version which use the newicons features.

To use AppReplaceIcon, you must have:

- an Amiga (for sure) (very uncommon!)

- a Kickstart 2.0 or higher
- 1 Mb of RAM should be enough
- newicon.library (only for the newicon version of AppReplaceIcon)

1.4 Usage

After you have selected an icon (of any type you want), an App-Icon will appear on the WorkBench screen. Now you can drag all the icons you want: they will be replaced with the icon selected at the start.

(You can drag several icons at one time).

When double-clicking app-icon, you can :

- * Select another replacement-icon
- * Modify the options
- * To have some informations (about)
- * Continue, to go on
- * Quit this wonderful program (oh no!)

In the options, you can indicate which ToolTypes and DefaultTool you want to keep :

- * None : nothing will be written in the futures icons
- * Keep : you will preserve your old ToolTypes/DefaultTool
- * SelectedIcon : you will put the ToolTypes/DefaultTool of the replacement-icon.

You can also set, the choice for the position of the icon to create (free or old position), if the type of the icon will be preserve or forced to one type of your choice.

Have fun! to relook your WorkBench...

v0.7 : 1 november 1995

One of the first versions.

v0.8 : 20 april 1996

Graphical User Interface for the choice of the save of the tooltypes and the defaulttool.

The position of the icon saved is disabled... coz of a little problem with a library.

v0.9 : 12 april 1997

A lot rewritten just because, the first version has grown in a bad way...

Now the choice for the position of the icons work.

v1.0 : 26 april 1997

Support for the newicons system using the newicon.library.

Thanks to Jon Peterson for his encouragement! Without him, you should have to wait more!

Bug fixed if you drag a drawer or disk, on a project/tool replacement icon... Unopable icon...(the structure drawerdata wasn't filled)

Bug: the stacksize wasn't kept (for a tool/project).

v1.1 : 31 january 1999

Using an ASL requester instead of the reqtools one (idea from Markus Lunk who detests reqtools). If you like ReqTools use a patch to force all ASL requesters to ReqTools.

In that way, you can use MUI-ASL or others...

Added the "continue" button in the requester "yes, sir" to avoid passing by the "about".
