This is the easy part, after you have installed SA make some startup's in your favorite text editor (i use blacks editor) and save them in the s:Sequences directory (created during installation) Make sure to save them with the SS file extension so the startup for PPaint becomes PPaint.SS, when you have created all of your startup's you should reboot your computer, you should here a bell sound (i might have taken it out) wich means that you have 1 second to press the left shift key or the system will use the standard startup-sequence but pressing the shift key will bring up a selection gui and all you have to do is pick the startup you want to use and click OK.
