#### 1.3 Introduction

My MultiView has configuration stored in tooltypes from version 1.5. But configuration was very hard work so I started to write preferences program. First versions was unusable - one have GUI, others not etc. In December 1997 I started work on really program. First versions can only read/write configuration but you can't change anything. I send 1st good version to Aminet in January 1998 - it was 1.1 beta.

Then I make many changes in code. After MultiView 4.0 release I wrote new preferences program which can handle all MV 4.0 settings and from then prefs program has the same version as MultiView which it can handle.
