<Help>	Current character to character editing box
	Delete current character
<Shift>+	Delete to end of text
<BS>	Delete previous character
<Shift>+<BS>	Delete to beginning of text
<Amiga>+<X>	Clear text buffer
<Amiga>+<Q>	Restore text buffer

<Cursor Left>	Move cursor one position to the left
<Shift>+<Cursor Left>	Move cursor to leftmost character in buffer
<Cursor Right>	Move cursor one position to the right
<Shift>+<Cursor Right>	Move cursor to rightmost character in buffer
<Cursor Up>	Move cursor to first character displayed
<Cursor Down>	Move cursor after last character displayed
<Return>	Activate main screen

The following shortcuts work in the "Quick Character Selection" mode (section 3.22):

KEY	COMMAND
<1>	Mode 1
<2>	Mode 2
<Esc>	Cancel

The following shortcuts can be selected when the "Define Character Set" function is active (section 4.10):

KEY	COMMAND
<[>	Increase Current Set Code
<]>	Decrease Current Set Code
<{>	Increase Amiga Set Code
<}>	Decrease Amiga Set Code

The following shortcuts work during the execution of a macro (sections 6.7, 6.9 and 6.10):

KEY	COMMAND
<Space>	Execute Next Command (step mode)
<Esc>	Stop Execution

The following shortcuts can be selected when the "Parameter Filter" requester is displayed (section 7.1):

KEY	COMMAND
<Cursor Left>	Disable Program Parameters
<Shift>+<Cursor Left>	Enable Program Parameters
<Cursor Right>	Disable Font Parameters
<Shift>+<Cursor Right>	Enable Font Parameters

When a requester having only the "Proceed", "Cancel" or "OK" gadgets is displayed, the following shortcuts can be selected (sections 1.10.11 and 1.10.15):

KEY	COMMAND
<Return>	Proceed or OK
<Enter>	Same as <Return>
<Esc>	Cancel or OK
