1.2 Introduction

URLLink is a set of AmigaDOS batch files that allow you to create a link to a web site, ftp site, an email address or any other kind of URL address. A link consists of a dynamically created batch file and an icon assigned to it. When you click on that icon, your standard web browser or mail client will be started with the provided address. To demonstrate what can be done with this I included an example that adds additional entries to the context menus of IBrowse which create a link on your Opus Magellan Desktop.

CreateURLLink:

- AmigaOS/68K >= Release 2.0 (Version 36)
Should run under AROS/68K and MorphOS/PPC as well. Couldn't test this.
- OpenURL, can be downloaded at Aminet:comm/www/OpenURL30.lha

CreateLinkOnDesktop additionally needs:

- AmigaOS/68K >= Release 3.0 (Version 39)
- MUI >= Release 3.8
- BetterString.mcc/.mcp Version >= 11.3
- MUIRequestString, can be downloaded at Aminet:util/batch/MUIRequestStr.lha
- SubStr , can be downloaded at Aminet:util/cli/SubStr.lha
- IBrowse 2.x
- Opus Magellan 5.xx

1.6 Installation

Automatically

Use the provided installation scripts.

Manually

Copy Icons/#? to ENVARC:sys/

Rename S/CreateLinkOnDesktop.<your_language> to S/CreateLinkOnDesktop

Copy S/CreateLinkOnDesktop to S:

Ensure that all files copied to S: have there protection bits set to RWEDS.

Copy URLLink.guide to HELP:English/

If you want to call CreateLinkOnDesktop from IBrowse read
this

1.7 Usage

Call from the shell as following:

CreateURLLink:

```
CreateURLLink URL/A, LINKNAME/A, PATH/A
```

All arguments are required.

URL is the full URL of the address the link should point to, e.g.

```
http://www.holzammer.net  
file:///Work:Introduction.pdf  
ftp://cz.aminet.net/pub/aminet/  
mailto:Development@Holzammer.net  
"mailto:Development@Holzammer.net?subject=Bug Report"
```

If the URL contains spaces the whole URL must be enclosed by "".

LINKNAME is the name of the link, e.g.

```
"Homepage of URLLink"  
Introduction  
"Czech Aminet (Full Mirror)"  
"Send a mail to the autor of URLLink"  
"Send a bug report to the author of URLLink"
```

If the linkname includes spaces you need to enclose it with "".
You may not use longer descriptions than the longest possible
length of filenames the filesystem supports - 5.
So for FastFileSystem the limit is usually 30-5=25,
for SmartFileSystem the limit is 107-5=98.

PATH is the path the created link file should be saved at.
If the path contains spaces it must be enclosed by "".
It must end in : or / !!

```
Work:Docs/ is a vaild path,  
Work:Docs is NOT !
```

? Shows above template and asks you for input.

CreateLinkOnDesktop:

CreateLinkOnDesktop URL/A

The argument is required.

URL is the full URL of the address the link should point to, e.g.

```
http://www.holzammer.net
file:///Work:Introduction.pdf
ftp://cz.aminet.net/pub/aminet/
mailto:Development@Holzammer.net
"mailto:Development@Holzammer.net?subject=Bug Report"
```

If the URL contains spaces the whole URL must be enclosed by "".

A requester will pop up to ask you for the LINKNAME. There is no shell argument for this as it is not really intended to call from shell directly but to call from IBrowse's context menu.

1.8 Configuration

This chapter will explain how to configure IBrowse to add some ↔ items to its context menus that will create a link on your (Opus Magellan) Desktop. There is no way to do this automatically, so you have to do it yourself.

Ok, step by step:

Read the chapters about
Requirements
and
Installation
.

Start IBrowse 2.x and open its settings window.

Jump to GUI/FAB Menus.

There are three groups arranged horizontally.
In the middle one you find th possible actions.
The right one contains the structure of the context menus.

Open node "Link" and drag/drop action "Custom" below it, directly to the ↔ position you'd like it to be.

Now click onto the new item and input a description into the first string gadget ↔
,
e.g. Create a link on Desktop

Choose Command from the cycle menu.

In the string gadget besides input S:CreateLinkOnDesktop.
The string gadget on the right should be set to %1.

Now open the Page menu and repeat what you have done for the Link menu.

Now save the configuration, load a document and test the new entries of the link and Page context menus.
