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### 1.3 Introduction

Introduction:

Welcome to AKIconzGold!

After having released 4  
collections  
of (mostly games) icons using the  
standard MagicWB colours  
I  
got bored of them. After seeing more and  
more people using the more colourful New- or even GlowIcons  
I  
looked  
over my simple 8 col. WB and decided to do something against it! ;-)

So

I  
was looking for possibilities to have a more colourful WB but  
without "OS 3.1 non-standard" stuff as NewIcons or GlowIcons.

First

I  
discovered the RomIcons and later the BNSMWBicons on Aminet  
and thought:

"WOW! They are looking great! Using a  
pre-defined 32-col. palette  
you could get such colourful (standard!) icons  
I  
never expected!".

Together with FBlit, which even makes a 32 col. DblPAL HiRes flickerfree  
screen work well on a 030/50 and without a gfx card this was the optimal  
solution in my eyes.

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And so the re-built of the whole icons and patterns scheme on my HD begun ...

After the existing icons did not cover all my needs  
I  
begun to create  
more and more by myself - and here are the first results ...

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## 1.4 Description

Description:

This is a collection of 16-/32-coloured icons in the BNSMWBicons style. As these icons, mine use the 8 MWB colours, expanded by the 8 RomIcons colours and again expanded by 13 more colours introduced with the 7th and corrected with the 8th release of the BNSMWBicons on Aminet.

For correct look the icons need a screen with 32 or more colours and a pre-defined

32-colour palette  
for the Workbench.

With this palette all your icons will have the right colours and so will look well:

- the original 8-colour MagicWB icons (anyone knows them!)
- the 16-colour RomIcons (often found in the installers of WHDLoad/jst)
- the 32-colour BNSMWBicons and so the AKIconzGold as well ;-)
- NewIcons (as the palette is using a wide-spread range of colours)
- and even GlowIcons will look relatively nice on a 32-col. screen (although you'll use a more colourful screenmode for them anyway...)

So if you don't want to restrict yourself to one sort of icons but always want to have the right colour settings for any icons, you should set this palette!

There are 300 icons for different apps, games (both incl. drawers), prefs, WBStartup tools and so on inside this collection.

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## 1.5 Installation

Installation:

1. Set the Workbench's screenmode to 32 or more colors.
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2. To get the correct colors, set/lock the following pens with Palette prefs and FullPalette or a similar tool:

3. Use a tool like IconInstaller for replacing your icons with these new ones.
