#### 1.4 Stewart Copeland

#### Stewart Copeland

Stewart Armstrong Copeland was born on 16.07.1952 in Alexandria, Virginia, USA. His father was famous trumpeter of Glenn Miller orchestra and important officer of CIA (here's the origin of band's name!). He spent his childhood in Cairo and Beirut, where he learnt to play drums. Later he studied in Berkeley's University of California. In 1972 his brother Miles asked him to be "on-road artistic director" for Cat Iron (he met Kim Turner then, the drummen and, later, soundman and co-manager of The Police) and then Joan Armatrading. After that he joined reunited Curved Air, but it

wasn't his dream as they were unable to produce something new and fresh (for commercial reasons). During their visit to Newcastle, Phil Sutcliffe, the rock journalist, took him to the concert of Last Exit, where he met Sting

The story of The Police begins here.

#### 1.5 Sting

#### Sting

Gordon Matthew Sumner was born on 02.10.1951 in Newcastle, England. In contrast to

Stewart

's childhood, he grew up in hard climate of workers' district. He started his musical education when he was at Catholic grammar school: his uncle left him a guitar. Later he listened to Charlie Mingus, Thelonious Monk (among others) and didn't like it too much (but hoped it make him good). In 1969 he started studies at university, but gave it up and spent a couple of years as unskilled labor, bus driver etc. Two years later he sorted it out, became a teacher and started to play in local bands. In 1974 (1972) he, with three members of The Newcastle Big Band (Jerry Richardson, John Hedley and Ronnie Pearson), formed Last Exit, recorded a single, play some concerts and... signed for Virgin. During one of these concerts he met

> Stewart Copeland and The Police began.

Andrew James Somers was born on 31.12.1942 in Poulton-le-Fylde, Lancashire, England. When he was 17, he joined Zoot Money's Big Roll Band and then New Animals, spending most of his time touring the States. After he returned to Great Britain (in 1973) he became a sideman and played with (among others) Neil Sedaka, David Essex, Kevin Coyne and Eberhard Schoener. He even played with Mike Oldfield during "Tubular Bells" concerts. During Mike Howlett's Gong concert in Paris he, Sting , Stewart and Mike Howlett played as

Strontium 90 . He liked it enough to join them, on 25.07.1977 (or in June), in The Police.
