

## CORVETTE-AMERICANA HALL of FAME

America's passion for sports may be surpassed only by its love of cars. Besides featuring the Corvette, this hall of fame is a time-walk through contemporary American culture, from 1953, when Chevrolet introduced its first 'Vette, to the present. Experience the sights and sounds of the way we've worked and played over the past 40 years. Each rare collector car is built into a dioramic Hollywood set of a famous American landmark like Mt. Rushmore, Niagara Falls, and the Alamo. The museum features a 1,000 song sound track that rocks through 40 years of music history. TV monitors take visitors through the events and personalities that molded the history of the past four decades. More than 1,000 "snippets" of TV shows, movies, commercials and sports are featured. The Corvette-Americana Hall of Fame time tunnel touches on the cultural phenomena of Marilyn Monroe, James Dean, Elvis Presley, Bruce Springsteen, Madonna and The Beatles with memorabilia items, and such fads as pet rocks, hula hoops, and Alf.
