Ed Cole's desire to produce the first American-made sports car resulted in him bringing chassis expert Maurice alley to Chevrolet in 1952 Maurice was Cole's hand-picked chief of Chevy research and development," said McLellan. Olley's task was to head a new research and development department that would fashion the first production Corvette. The department had full responsibility for the design of the car's chassis, and within days of his arrival at Chevrolet, Olley already had the new Corvette sketched out to perfection. As alley once modestly stated, "GM produced a sports car using components of known reliability, with adequate performance and with a comfortable ride." They also made history.
