The nickname 'one arm bandit' applies to today's slot machines as much as it ever has. Each of a slot machine's reels has about 20 symbols on it, but there is by no means an equal chance of the reel stopping on each (as was the case on older machines). Which symbol each reel will stop on is determined before the reels even start spinning, so just because your spin landed on the lemon just below the lucky-7 doesn't mean that you almost hit that jackpot. Winning Strategy There is no real winning strategy for slots, except perhaps to find that elusive 'loose' machine and always play the maximum number of coins so that if you do hit a jackpot, you'll be paid well for your effort.

Three Reel Machine The three reel machines in Beat the House are similar to many found in casinos. Each coin inserted (up to five coins) buys a payoff line. Multiple lines may win and payoff on any one spin. As with the progressive machine, it is best to play all five coins in a machine like this one because the jackpot payoffs increase with each coin played. uFour Reel Progressive Progressive machines are the latest trend in Las Vegas. By having several slot machines (often in several casinos) pay

into the same jackpot, it grows very quickly and is won fairly often. The jackpot is won by the first person who hits the jackpot and played all three coins. Always play the maximum number of coins on a progressive machine.

Pay-out Percentages Most slot machines pay out from 83% to 90% as much money as is inserted into them. This means that for every 100 dollars you put in the coin slot, about 85 dollars will drop back out, on the average. These are terrible odds, and because of them, playing the slots is not recommended. The slots in this game are loose compared to the average machine with the 3 reel machine paying out 96% and the 4 reel progressive paying out 94%. Also, you have about a one in six million chance of hitting the progressive jackpot each spin. Good Luck! **|�** 

Inserting Coins
This is one of the most
difficult slot skills to
master. If the coin is
inserted too gently it might
get jammed in the slot. If the
coins are inserted to
forcefully you may tire to
quickly from the exertion to
win the big jackpot.

This is a skill that cannot be taught by a simulation. The only way to acquire the correct touch is through experience. Some veteran slot players recommend practicing on coke machines or video games. We do not endorse these controversial methods.

BPulling the Handle
Once the coin insert has been
mastered it is time to move
on to the handle pull. Newer
machines are equipped with
spin buttons allowing the
naive player to forgo the arm
pull altogether. Do not be
fooled by these little
buttons. It is common
knowledge in Vegas that the
only way to win big is to
pull the handles, the spin
buttons are for losers.

Acting Excited
Should you win big at the
slots be sure to jump around
and act excited. Everyone in
the casino loves to see
someone jumping up and down
and screaming in front of a
ringing, flashing slot
machine. Don't let your fellow
gamblers down.



## Etiquette

There is only one hard and fast rule of slot machine etiquette. If you wouldn't do it at a bowling alley, don't do it here.
