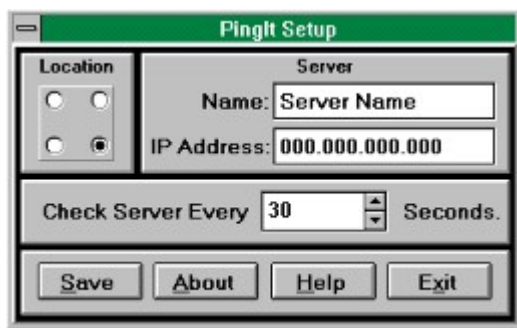
Configuring PingIt

To open the PingIt popup menu, move the mouse pointer over the PingIt window and press the right mouse button.

There are two menu options available, **Setup** and **Exit**.

1) Setup:

The **Setup** option brings up the PingIt Setup window with the following options:



- * The **Location** setting is used to tell PingIt where to sit on the screen. Each button represents the corresponding screen location: Top - Left & Right and Bottom - Left & Right
- * The **Server** box contains the **Name** and the **IP Address** of the connection you want to monitor. The **Name** box is a text field used to display the name of the server, you can type in any name you wish. **IP Address** is the actual IP Address that PingIt will ping to determine if communication is available between the two machines.
- * The **Check Server Every ____ Seconds** is the amount of time (in seconds) that passes between each ping attempt. Valid values are 10 to 3600.
- * The four buttons perform the following functions:
 - Save:** Saves the current settings to the PingIt INI file.
 - About:** Displays the About box with company information.
 - Help:** Displays this help file
 - Exit:** Closes the Setup PingIt window.

2) Exit:

The **Exit** option closes and exits the PingIt program.

Shareware

DEFINITION OF SHAREWARE

Shareware distribution gives users a chance to try software before buying it. If you try a Shareware program and continue using it, you are required to register it. Copyright laws apply to both Shareware and retail software, and the copyright holder retains all rights, with a few specific exceptions as stated below. Shareware authors are accomplished programmers, just like retail authors, and the programs are of comparable quality. (In both cases, there are good programs and bad ones!) The main difference is in the method of distribution. The author specifically grants the right to copy and distribute the software, either to all and sundry or to a specific group. For example, some authors require written permission before a commercial disk vendor may copy their Shareware.

Shareware is a distribution method, not a type of software. You should find software that suits your needs and pocketbook, whether it's retail or Shareware. The Shareware system makes fitting your needs easier, because you can try before you buy. And because the overhead is lower, prices are lower also. Shareware has the ultimate money-back guarantee -- if you don't use the product, you don't pay for it.
