

## GIFSCOPE

GIFSCOPE is the program that actually does the work of packing up GIF files into a single “proof sheet” or “thumbnail” file. It supports a variety of image sizes from 640 x 480 to 1280 x 1024, and has command line parameters for additional processing. The THMBNAIL.BAT file should look like this, and should be located in your Batch directory:

```
C:\WC5\WCREDIR C:\WC5\GIFSCOPE /WILDCAT /RES:%1 /OUT:%2
```

Wildcat! passes the resolution as %1 and the name of the output file as %2. The /WILDCAT switch tells GIFSCOPE to get the names of the callers queued-up GIF files directly from Wildcat!. You can see a complete list of command line parameters by typing

```
GIFSCOPE /? [enter]
```

Just as with other batch files, you can have .RUN or .BAT versions of this file, in the Node and Batch file directories, respectively.

### **I don't want to offer thumbnails. How do I turn them off?**

Delete the file THMBNAIL.BBS from your display directory. If you have defined separate display paths for languages and conferences, remember to delete THMBNAIL.BBS from those additional paths also.
