

Automatic Mailcheck 2.9 for Windows 95 from Simret Computing

Automatic Mailcheck 2.9 is shareware. This means that if you decide to use the program, you will have to pay for it. When you pay, you will receive a registration key which will give you access to all the features in Automatic Mailcheck. The registration cost \$15 and can be done at <http://www.simret.com>

Restrictions in the Shareware version

Here is a list of the differences between the shareware version and the full version:

- The shareware version shows a startup screen, telling you this program is shareware at startup.
- In the full version, you will be able to configure the program to hide itself at startup. Leaving only the little trayicon.
- In the full version, you can get a messagebox on the screen, every time new mail has arrived.
- In the full version, you will be able to play multimedia soundfiles when new mail has arrived.
- In the full version, you can check up to 10 POP-accounts for mail. The shareware version allows only one POP account.

The POP Tab

In this tab, you set which POP accounts Automatic Mailcheck 2.9 should logon to, to check for new mail. You can check up to 10 pop accounts. For each POP account you will have to specify an userid, a password and the name of the POP server. The **On** and **Off** controls can be used to decide which POP accounts should be active or inactive.

Note: In the shareware version, only one POP account can be checked for mail.

If you have made any changes to any of the settings, the changes will be saved automatically.

The Options Tab

Here you can specify if the application window should be hidden right after startup. This is very useful if you put it in your startup folder for example.

Note: In the shareware version this option is not activated.

You also use this tab to set the interval between mailchecking. This can be a value from 10 seconds to 60 minutes. Instead of specifying intervals between checking, you can specify at what times the mailbox should be checked. For example: 00,15,30,45 will make Automatic Mailcheck check your POP account for new mail at 11:00, 11:15, 11:30, 11:45, 12:00, 12:15.....

In the Mail-application field, you can enter the commandline for your mail application. You can then start your mail application from the trayicons menu.

The Notifications Tab

In this tab you can select how you should be notified, when new mail has arrived. You can choose to have a normal system sound, play an multimedia sound file (*.wav) or none at all. You can also choose to have a messagebox pop up onto your screen, telling you how many messages is waiting to be read.

Note: In the shareware version, the playing of multimedia files and the messagebox option is not activated.

The Feedback Tab

Please use this tab to send feedback to the developers. Fill in the required information. You will have to specify the name of your mail server. This is not the same as your POP server. If you are not sure, try **mail.domain**. For example, let's say your provider's server is sn.no. Then try **mail.sn.no** as your mail server and **pop.sn.no** as your pop server.

Please specify if your feedback is a comment / suggestion or a bug report. This is important, since the messages are processed automatically.
