

Ted's Button WAVs 96 -- Volume 2

Thanks for downloading **Ted's Button WAVs 96 -- Volume 2** (of 2). There are 27 WAVs in this first archive. All are female voiced with the names of standard Windows 3.1 and 95 buttons. You'll need a third-party sound hooking utility to attach these sounds to the buttons so that when the button is pushed, the sound is played. (I use Aristosoft's *Wired For Sound Pro*, but there are other commercial and shareware utilities that can do this like *KABOOM!* and *Icon Hear-It*.) Many of these sounds could be hooked to Windows dialog boxes as well.

(Note: I produced a similar collection of female-voiced button sounds a while back, but I used a different voice for this new collection, plus sampled them at higher quality. Also, some of the button sounds in this 1996 collection are especially suitable for buttons in Windows 95.)

All WAVs are original creations. Each was originally recorded in a professional broadcast studio and then sampled in 16-bit mono at 22k using the excellent commercial WAV editor *Sound Forge 4.0* from Sonic Foundry. Levels were normalized to give consistent playback volume, and each sound was expertly edited.

These sounds are freely distributed for personal, non-commercial use. Companies or software authors who wish to license these sounds for commercial use should contact the author for more information.
