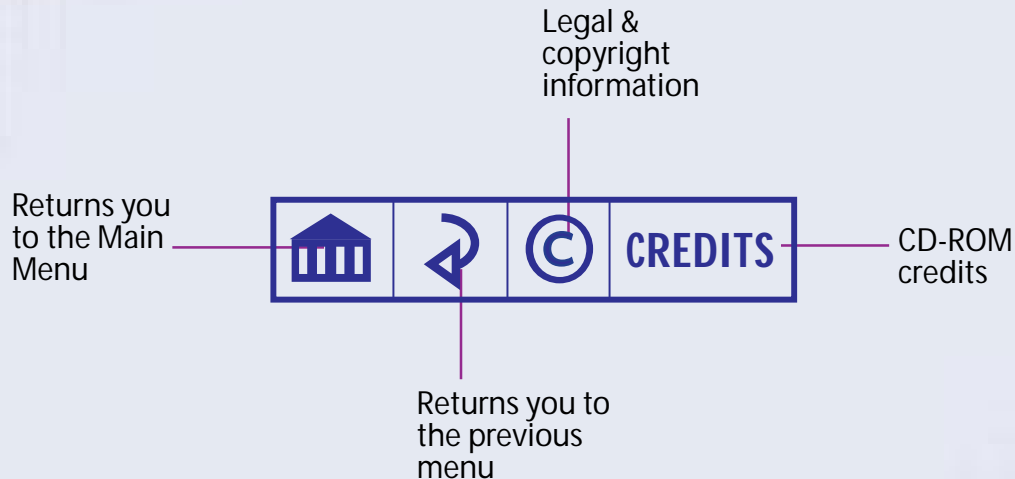

Exploring the Adobe Graphics and Publishing Software Development Kit

Use the following toolbar buttons explained below to navigate this CD. To go directly to a particular section, click on the section's link (●).

To return to the previous menu after opening a technical document file on the CD, use the close box in the upper left corner of the document window.



Searching the CD

To use the full-text search features in Acrobat, you will need to do the following:

- 1) Launch Acrobat Exchange or Acrobat Reader 3.0 with Search Plug-in which is included on the CD.
- 2) After launching the Acrobat software, using the Tools menu, scroll down to Search and select Indexes. Make sure you have loaded the Search Plug-in from the Optional folder to the Plug-ins folder in Exchange or Reader.
- 3) Add the FILE XXIndex.pdx (where XX is a two-three letter identifier for the particular SDK name). We have included an index in each of the SDKS. After installing 1 or more SDKS, you will notice a file titled PRIndex, PMIndex, etc. Select each index from each SDK that you are installing.

You will notice a FOLDER titled, "Index". This folder is used by the Acrobat application for search functions only. Simply keep it with the SDKs.
